









# Global Arms Sales (Exporters vs. Importers)



#### Target zero

It's possible to reach net zero carbon by 2060 at very low emission levels. But at higher levels, it may not be possible to reach that goal in this century, the IPCC says.

#### Human Influence

Human influence has warmed the atmosphere, ocean and land. Widespread and rapid changes in the atmosphere, ocean, cryosphere and biosphere have occured globally.



#### **Global Warming**

Global warming of 1.5°C and 2°C will be exceeded during the 21st century, unless there are deep reductions in CO2 and other greenhouse gas emissions in the coming decades. The 1.5°C global warming level will be crossed by the early 2030s.



#### Sea Level Rise

The rate of global mean sea level rise has accelerated and will continue throughout the 21st century, ranging from 0.32m to 1.01m. While projections are comparable to the IPCC's Fifth Assessment Report (AR5), there might be a disproportionate impact on low-lying states in the tropics due to "High Impact – Low Likelihood" events.



#### Weather and Climate Extremes

Every region in the world is projected to experience concurrent and multiple changes in climatic impact-drivers resulting in more frequent and/or severe droughts, more intense and frequent extreme rainfall events, and flooding. Changes would be more widespread at 2°C and above, as compared to 1.5°C global warming.






# India Accidentally Hitting Missile in Pakistan

- On 9 March 2022, India accidently fired a BrahMos missile originating from Sirsa, Haryana that crashed into Mian Channu, Khanewal District, Punjab, Pakistan.
- On 23rd August, Indian Air Force sacked three officers for accidentally firing a missile into Pakistan in March, an incident that the two nuclear-armed rivals handled calmly as there were no casualties.






















# **Appointment in Supreme Court**







# The House Passes the America COMPETES Act



WASHINGTON — Today, the U.S. House of Representatives passed the America Creating Opportunities for Manufacturing Pre-Eminence in Technology and Economic Strength (America COMPETES) Act. This bipartisan legislation will increase U.S. production of semiconductor chips, strengthen the supply chain to make more goods in America, and invest in scientific research and new technologies, while supporting strong labor standards and human rights. It includes Rep. Madeleine Dean's Combatting Wildlife Trafficking Financing and Proceeds Study Act (H.R. 6477). These provisions will require the Treasury

Secretary to conduct a study about global wildlife trafficking and its proceeds.







### Madeleine Albright

The United States' first female Secretary of State has died of cancer at age 84.

Born in Prague, Czech Republic on May 15, 1937.

She fled the Nazis as a child during World War II.

She became US ambassador to the United Nations in 1993 and pressed for tougher lines against Serbs in Bosnia.


She was confirmed Secretary of State in 1997, becoming the first woman to take the post.

In 2000, she became the highest-ranking US official to meet Kim Jong II, pressing North Korea to end its nuclear programme.








- Criticisms:
  - It has been called the 'West Asian Quad' by some commentators.
  - Criticised for having the USA's hidden agenda to "contain" Iran in the geopolitics of West Asia.
  - India never ever got entangled in the intra-regional issues in West Asia and critics want India to refrain from being part of this alliance.

#### **Significance**

- · Better engagement with the Middle Eastern region.
- Signifies Israel's increasing integration into the region, through the Abraham Accords.
- Helps India's growing engagement with countries in West Asia including Israel, with whom India has developed closer ties.
- India's bilateral strategic ties with each of the three countries have been on an upswing in the last few years.
