

Paragraph 3-

Increase in Population has increased the water crisis in Pakistan. Water crisis in Pakistan is gaining momentum and one of the main cause of this deteriorating condition is rapid growth in population of Pakistan. The resources of fresh water are scarce in Pakistan and with increase in population the availability per person is declining. This is not only affecting the availability of water but also causing food insecurity as water is key ingredient in cultivating crops. According to a report, Pakistan's population has increased 2.6 times between 1972 and 2020, but the total water resources remained static at 246.8 billion cubic meters, resulting in a decrease in per capita water resources. Therefore population growth has resulted in an increase pressure on water resources and its contribution to the water crisis cannot be denied.

Effect of Covid 19 on education in Pakistan. Covid 19 has negatively affected the education system in Pakistan. During the pandemic, schools, colleges and universities were closed for several months thus, badly affecting the learning process of students. Although online classes system was introduced but many students were left out because of lack of access to internet or mobile phones, network connectivity issues, low level of motivation or simply the affordability issues. According to a report pandemic has affected the learning process of approximately 40 million students across Pakistan. Similarly a study by UNICEF suggests that students learned significantly less from home, compared with class room learning before pandemic. Thus, pandemic has influenced the education system negatively.
