

Unit 6: Conditionals

1st Conditional sentences:

- If you visit, we will go to the theatre.
- If it rains, we will eat inside.
- If you do not pass the exam, you will take it again?
- We ~~do~~ ^{will} lose our way if we ~~will~~ ^{do} not stay on the main road.
- He ~~will~~ ^{will} not catch the plane if he ~~will~~ ^{does} not stay on the main road.
- I ^{will} ring telephone if I ~~will~~ need any help.

2nd Conditional sentences:

- If you did more exercise, you would feel better.
- What ^{would} will you do, if you won a million pounds?
- If someone ^{came} comes in here with a gun, I would be very frightened.

• If I were you, I would learn French before travelling to France.

• I am sure Fred **would understand** if you **explained** the situation to him.

• My husband **would be** very upset, if I **lost** my wedding ring.

Conditional 3:-

• If Kim had not missed her flight, she would have not met her ^{future} husband Tom!

• If he had driven more carefully, he would not have an accident.

• ~~For~~ If we had bought a lottery ticket, we would have won a fortune!

• They would have won the race if the weather conditions had been better.

• I would have not failed the exam, if I had worked harder.

• What you would have done, if you had ~~saw~~ the thief ~~stolen~~ the jewels.
