

## Unit 6: Conditionals

### 1st Conditional sentences:

- If you visit, we will go the theatre.
- If it rains, we will eat inside.
- If you do not pass the exam, you will take it again?
- We ~~do~~ <sup>will</sup> lose our way if we ~~will~~ <sup>do</sup> not stay on the main road.
- He ~~do~~ <sup>will</sup> not catch the plane if he ~~will~~ <sup>does</sup> not stay on the main road.
- I ~~ring~~ <sup>will</sup> telephone if I ~~will~~ <sup>need</sup> any help.

### 2nd Conditional sentences:

- If you did more exercise, you would feel better.
- What ~~wil~~ <sup>would</sup> you do, if you won a million pounds?
- If someone ~~comes~~ <sup>came</sup> in here with a gun, I would be very frightened.

If I were you, I would learn French before travelling to France.

would understand

I am sure Fred understood, if you ~~would~~ explained the situation to him.

would be

My husband was very upset, if I ~~would~~ lost my wedding ring.

### Conditional 3:-

If Kim had not missed her flight, she would have not met her <sup>new</sup> husband Tom!

If he had driven more carefully, he would not have an accident.

~~If~~ If we had bought a lottery ticket, we would have won a fortune!

They would have won the race if the weather conditions had been better.

I would have not failed the exam, if I had worked harder.

What you would have done, if you had seen the thief stolen the jewels
