Mass media is playing greater role in shaping perceptions of masses around the world regarding terrorism. It has portrayed a bleak picture of muslim world as originator and promoter of terrorism. While presenting some stories of west in more mild way witness biased role of media. Media has failed in differentiating between terrorism and freedom fight. Instead it has associated these terms based on the division of world; global north and global south. Few powerful and hegemonic states used ~~ever~~ have furthered their political motives using muslims and Islam as a cover to ^{Conceal} protect their genocide. All around the world, an ~~single~~ act of muslim individual gets attached to the whole muslim community while such act in west world remains confined to that particular individual not with the whole western christian community. This situation gets worsened in absence of strict code of conduct for media especially social media which enjoys a large number of followers. Media in the world is financially dependent and prefers to remain loyal with west to meet its financial needs. As a result of

media's biased role muslim world have suffered a lot in social, economic, political and almost all spheres of life. Media and world leaders, especially of US, EU and China, should realize their role and part accordingly. (This is the dire need of the hour because world is already on the edge of the war. Any insignificant event could worsen the situation by bringing states into third world war which is cyber war. (200)

Terrorism is an act of using and abusing force for political or vested interest. This term has emerged into world since 1979, after Russian invasion in Afghanistan. On the other hand, freedom fight is a struggle for some collective interest, rights and in some cases self-determination. Media has failed in distinguishing freedom fighters and terrorism on basis of their true meaning and situation. Instead, it has associated terrorism with muslim world particularly and freedom fight with mighty greater powers and their allies. For example, they call Palestinian Kashmiri freedom fighters as terrorist while Israeli attentive as freedom fighters or defenders.

This form of presentation has ~~shaping~~ public thoughts in ~~the way~~ in ~~which~~ a common man, living in Australia or Europe who ~~never~~ ^{neither} met with any muslim nor eye witnessed any terror attack by muslim, but still thinks of a muslim community as sponsor of terrorism. (110)

There are several factors behind this perception of a common white man. Media has influenced his thoughts greatly. The first and foremost factor is western influence on media. Almost ~~the~~ whole world ~~greatly~~ ^{wholly} depends on western news agencies, associated press and others, for ~~setting~~ news. Western countries own more than 80% satellites and other high technical equipment to cover and control news. Western media molds stories in a way to paint muslim world as offenders and terrorist. They distribute these news throughout the world which further reinforce a ~~worse~~ perception regarding terrorism and muslims. (80)

World leaders, ~~US~~ and ~~EU~~, have their political agendas to promote through presenting muslims as terrorists. The main reason behind using media against muslims is to suppress

muslim world. Islam is ~~the~~ most growing religion of the world with emerging number of followers. Western community fears the influence of muslims over world order. Moreover, they have misinterpreted the concept of "Jihad". Media uses "Jihad" as a ~~lego~~ warrent to muslims by religion to fight and spread terrorism in world. (80)

In media stories a fact to be ^{critically} observed is that whenever media reports a terrorist or violent event ~~of~~ ^{by} a muslim, ^{media} ~~it~~ terms it as ~~an~~ -terrorist attacks without even looking for facts and cross validating them to check either its an attack or freedom fight. On the other hand same event in west reported with generous and tolerant language by calling ~~commiter~~ ^{Whore} as insane or mentally ill. This biasness of media has reinforced among masses sentiments against muslims. (80)

In our global system media claims to be free and fair but in reality it has financial constraints which do not let media ~~to~~ play its role fairly. Western countries being developed and economically strong

give financial aids to media. It is natural phenomenon that media cannot report against western interests. ~~and~~ In exchange of finance, media has assumed responsibility to promote western ~~int~~ agenda by compromising their code of ethics.

Another factor that intensifying ~~es~~ the world sentiments is wide coverage of media with the emergence of technology. Social media has a far greater reach than newspapers and radio had in past. In ~~this~~ ^{the} age of information, every person ~~is~~ ~~greatly~~ gets influenced ~~from~~ ^{by} media. These technologies have made information ~~to~~ spread within seconds. Events are ~~being~~ reported on Twitter and other social media apps. The users of social media have ~~mostly~~ no age bracket today. This has impacted public mind and molded their opinion regarding ~~see~~ terrorism and muslims.

Technology with its pros and cons has ~~created~~ a ~~wrecked~~ havoc ~~on~~ ^{the} world. ~~It~~ ^{Countries} have ~~less~~ ^{less} ~~been~~ ^{less} ~~weakened~~ the control of ~~authorities~~ over social media and other ~~ways~~ ^{of} technologies. media than newspapers. Due to this freedom world have no strict code of conduct and control mechanism in media. Another mounting issue is world's leader's reluctance to impose restrictions to control exploitation of muslim world. ~~and~~ These unfair role of media has impacted muslim world badly.

UN human rights organization works for ~~human~~ rights of ~~the~~ people around the world. Charter of UN ~~was~~ ensured equality of ~~all~~ but due to media's made-up perception, ~~a~~ ~~great~~ emergence of racism

and ethnicity is witnessed. For example, many students from muslim countries face racial abuse in western countries. They are ethnically undermined due to ethnic differences. Black people are not considered equal to white ones. They are forced to do low-wages jobs.
