is increased in Ukraine and demographic situation is shifted to pro-Europe. More than 70pc, people are pro-Europe; and only 25pc are pro-Russia. Hence, demographic shift is become a dispute between Russia and Ukraine.

3- Causes of attack of Russia on Ukraine

Following are main causes of attack of Russia on Ukraine:

a) NATO penetration into Russian sphere of influence

After 1991, NATO started penetration into Russian sphere. Eastern Europe, Nordic, and Baltic countries were moved towards NATO. Not only this, but NATO moved toward Georgia - 2000 onward attempted to join

EU and NATO alliance. This hurt geo-strategic importance of Russia.

b) Westward mobility of Ukraine

Ukraine also moved towards westward mobility as follows:

i) Applied for EU and NATO

First attempt of Ukraine to join EU and NATO membership, became a cause of dispute between Russia and Ukraine.

ii) Trade and people's mobility

Ukraine wanted to start trade relations with the western world that also resulted Russian-Ukraine war.

iii) Ukraine's approach to NATO

Moreover, Ukraine wanted to purchase weapons from NATO countries, such as US, UK, Spain, Germany.

iv) Ukraine's attempt to join NATO alliance

Ukraine wanted to increase its defence exercise with NATO countries. Hence, above all attempts towards the west made Russia

to attack on Ukraine.

a) Humanitarian loss

According to an update, 6919 people killed and more than 11,000 were wounded. Thus, Russian attack devastated Ukraine.

b) Economic loss

Along with humanitarian loss, survival of people was also affected. More than half of agriculture was devastated. Ukraine, the 2nd largest grain producer country was deprived of food.

c) Urban life in danger

Moreover, urban life

was destroyed severely. Due to this Ukraine's loss was 600 bn \$. Further, 70 pc of Ukraine - was totally destroyed.

d) Refugees increased

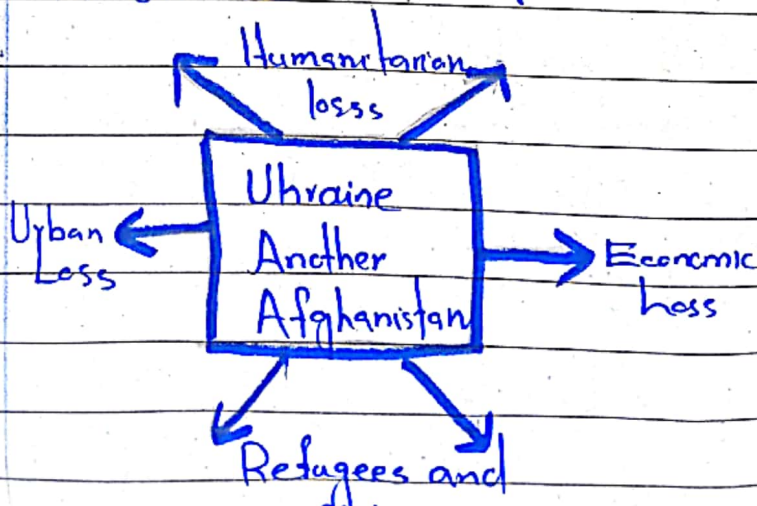
As life was in danger due to attack. Almost 3.6 million people moved across border to Eastern Europe, Nordic and Baltic countries.

a) Fear back in Europe

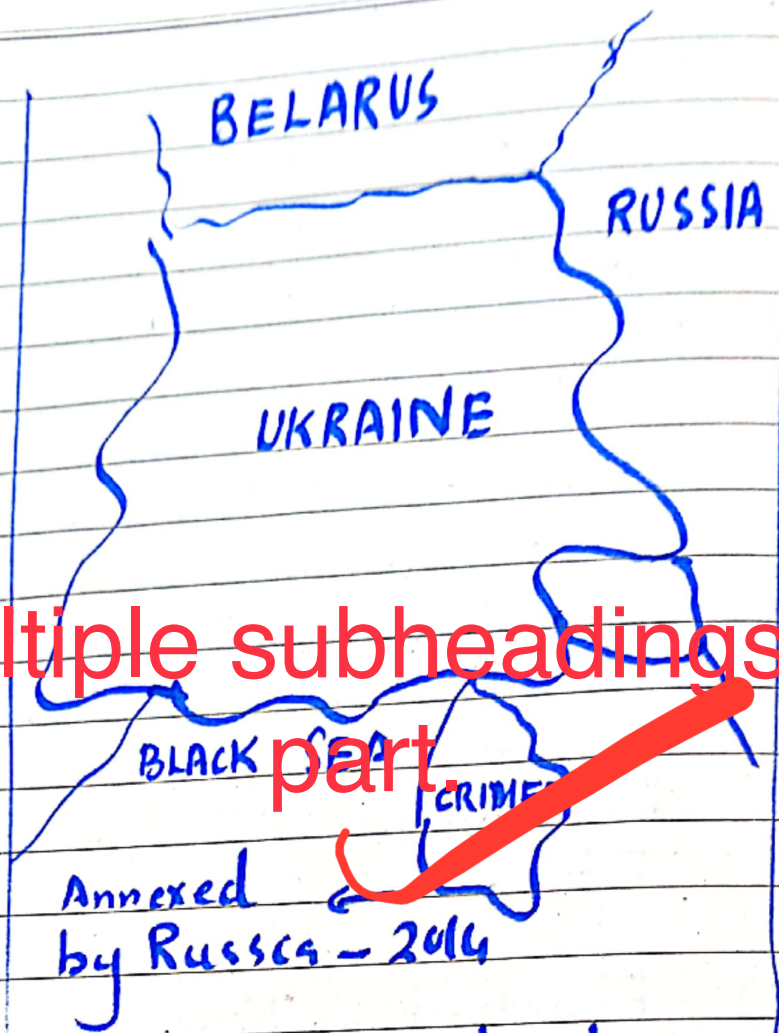
