ii) Curtailment by USA

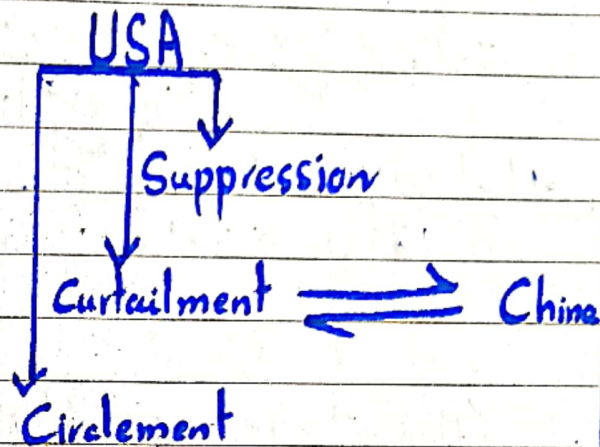
Along with suppression, curtailment is also done by USA and its allies. This, hence, is increasing rivalry in the world contemporary.

by AUKUS platform

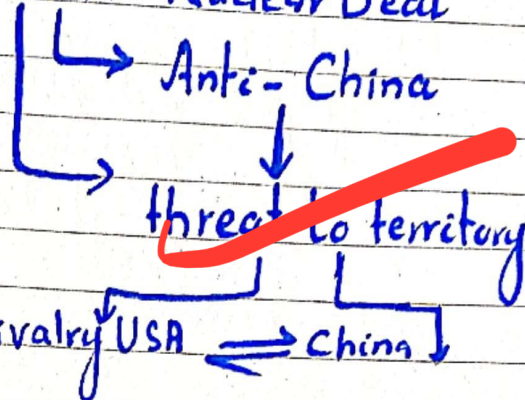
