2. Definition of a federal system.

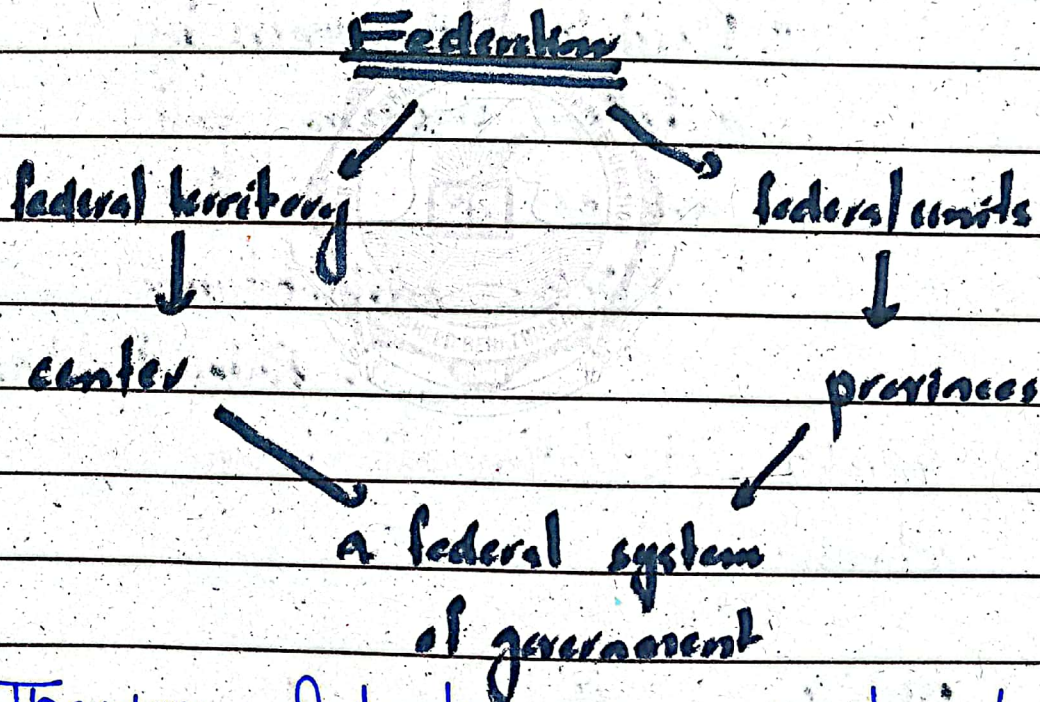

d) Deep-rooted ethnicity among the nation

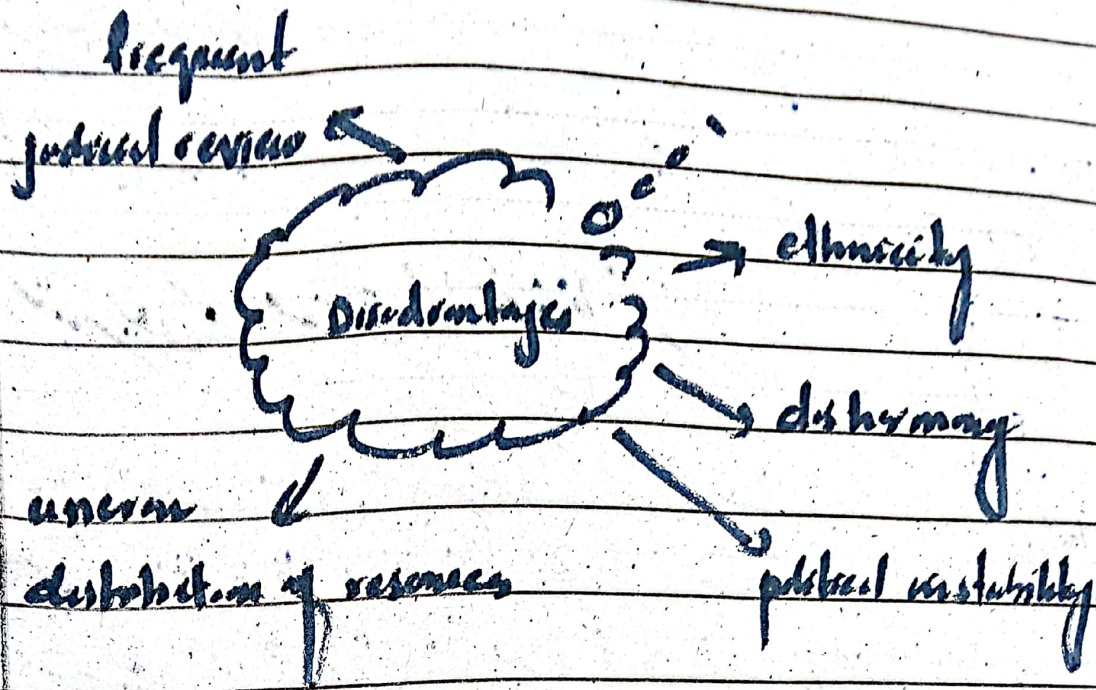
Furthermore, deep-rooted ethnicity is one of disadvantages. Multi-cultural nation is divided on multi-issues and pursue own interests.
