"Criminal behavior is an unwanted personality of a criminal."

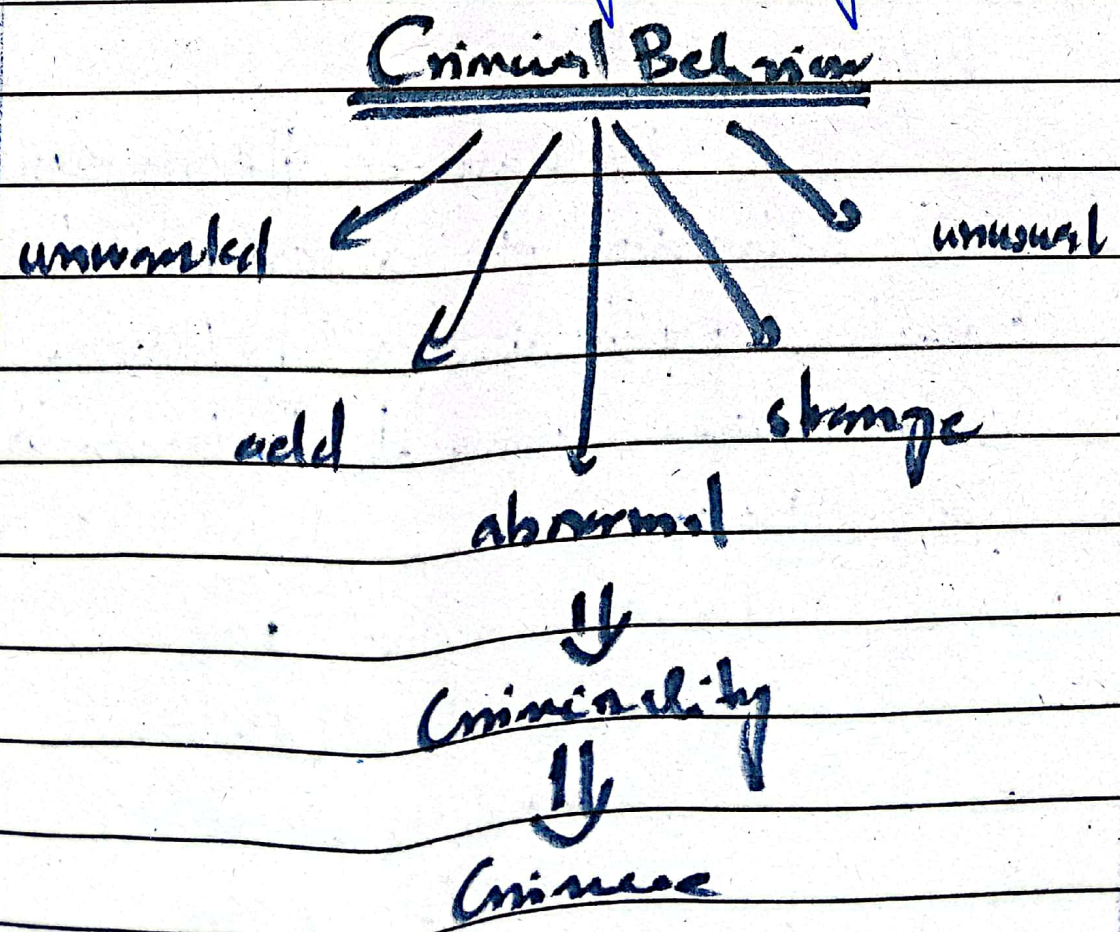

"Criminal behavior is abnormal activities representing a person."

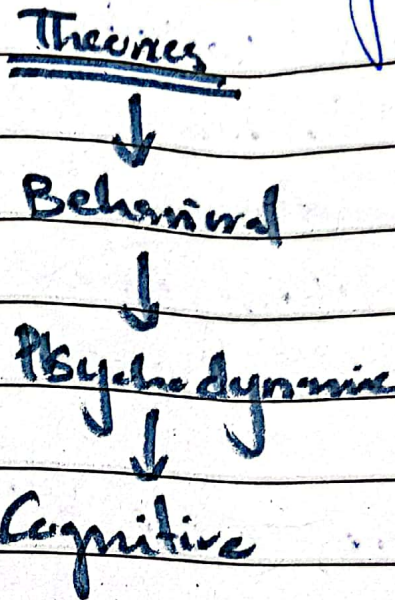

Typology has focus on crime and criminal behavior. In fact, typology leads to identification in relation of crime with criminality. Therefore, typology is an important factor in criminology.

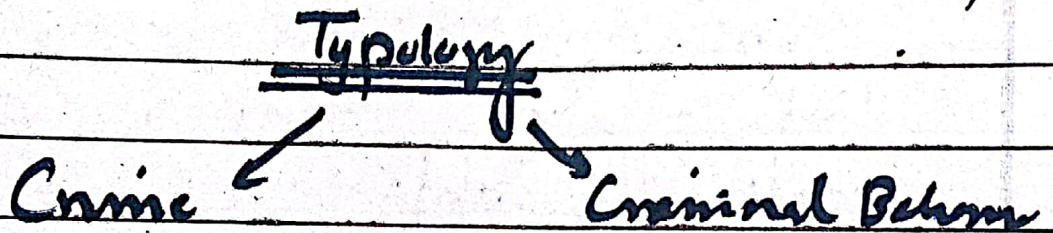
2- Definition of 'typology', Relation between a person's crime and his criminal behavior, known as typology.

Hence typology has detail functioning of crime.

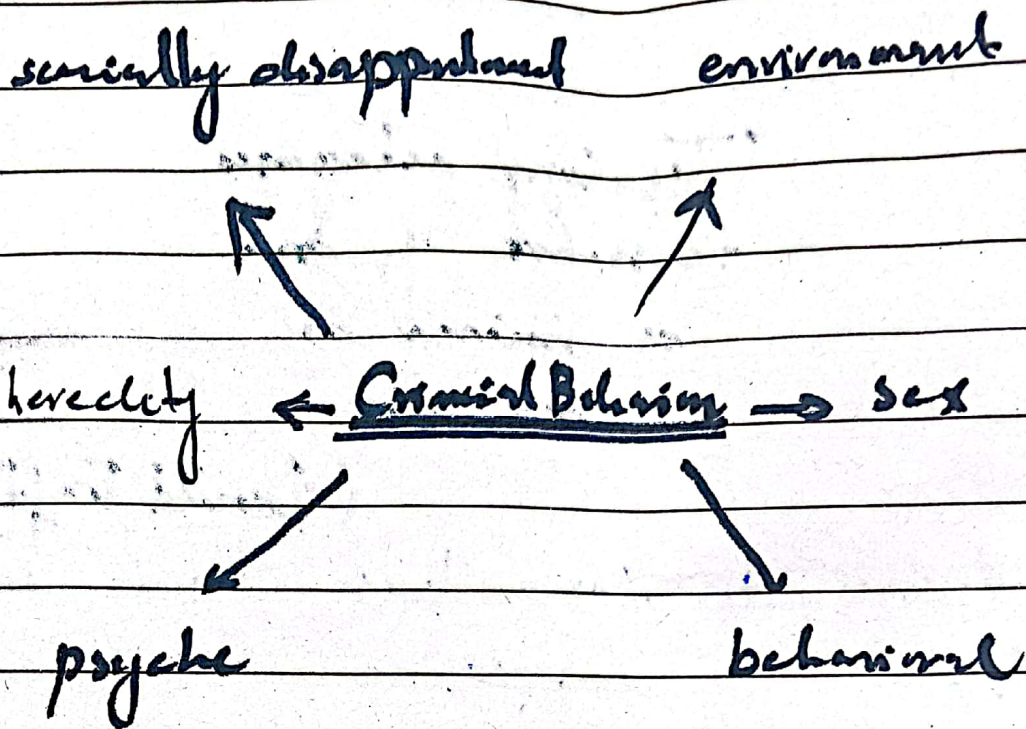
b) Factors of criminal behaviour
