⇒ Her husband told her that he would not go to the office that day as he was not feeling well.
- 5) My father has said to me, "I fear that you have caught a cold again."
⇒ My father has told me that he fears that I have caught a cold again.
- 6) His brother said to me, "I am not going to attend the meeting today."
⇒ His brother told me that he was not going to attend the meeting that day.
- 7) The inspector said to the people, "We have caught the thief and he will be brought to book soon?"
⇒ The inspector told the people that they had caught the thief and he would be brought to book soon.

- 8) The lady said to her husband, "Whether you agree with me or not, I am not going to change my decision."
⇒ The lady told her husband that whether he agreed with her or not, she was not going to change her decision.
- 9) The landlord has said to the young man, "If you do not pay your rent by evening today you will have to leave the house immediately."
⇒ The landlord has told the young man that if he does not pay his rent by that evening he will have to leave the house immediately.
- 10) His wife said to him, "Do you know that my servant stole our money?"
⇒ His wife asked him whether he knew that their servant had stolen their money.
- 11) Her friend said to her, "Can you spare your book for me for a week?"
⇒ Her friend asked her whether she could spare her book for a week.
- 12) She said to him, "Can I do anything for you? Will you mind my extending help to you?"
⇒ She asked him whether she could do anything for him and whether he would mind her extending help to him.
- 13) His friend has said to him, "Did I not warn you against this beforehand?"
⇒ His friend ^{has} asked him whether he did not warn him against that beforehand.
- 14) The captain said to the players, "Will you put your heart and soul in playing the game so that we may win the match?"
⇒ The captain asked the players whether they would put their heart and soul in playing the game so that they might win the match.
