Lack of Funds to Improve Education in Pakistan.

There are inadequate funds for improving education sector in Pakistan. The country is grappling with economic shocks. Declining foreign-direct investments, dwindling influx of remittances, increasing domestic demands and rising payments make the government unable to flow more funds in the education. The Comparative analysis of the Economic Surveys of Pakistan shows that Pakistan spent 2 percent of its GDP on education in 2016-17. But in the fiscal year 2021-22, the expenditure on Education stood at 1.7 percent of GDP. Hence, such drastic

decrease in the funding is due
to economic incapacity of Pakistan.
