Pakistan ranks 129 out of 140 in rule of law index. The govt has failed to ensure rule of law in the country. It did not take any initiatives for the provision of rule of law. So, it is need to ensure and focus on the provision of law that leads the states towards economic prosperity and economic development.

Similarly, Pakistan need to focus on impartial accountability. Our system of accountability has also remains elusive in Pakistan. Numerous efforts have been made in the past to institute a credible mechanism of accountability but almost all such efforts failed to win the trust of the people and establish which could continue at a steady pace without being interrupted by political exigencies. According to world transparency index, Pakistan

ranked 180 out of 180. So, there is dire need to revisist current accountability law in this way Pakistan will go towards economic development.

Furthermore, Pakistan need to develop fair economic policies. Economic policies covers a wide range of measures like monetary policies, taxation, budget, job creation etc. Pakistan is facing lots of economic crisis due to unfair monetary policies, budget deficit, flawed taxation system, trade deficit.

According to economic survey Pakistan GDP growth rate is 0.5% which has decreased as GDP growth was 6.0% (FY 2022). Now, it is the need of hour, that Pakistan made fair and sustainable economic policies by providing health facilities, creating jobs opportunities this leads the pakistan to achieve the status of developed nation.

Similarly, for achieving the status of developed nation pakistan need to invest in health, population and creates job opportunities. In health sectors pakistan is facing lots of problems due to lack of facilities, shortages of medicines and paramedical staff.
