- My father told me that he fear I had caught a cold again.

6) His brother said to me, "I am not going to attend the meeting today."

- His brother told me that he wouldn't be attending the meeting that day.

7) The inspector said to the people, "We have caught the thief and he will be brought to book soon."

- The inspector told the people that they had caught the thief and he would be brought to book soon.

8) The lady said to her husband, "Whether you agree with me or not I am not going to change my decision."

- The lady told her husband that whether he agreed with her ^{or} not, she wouldn't change her decision.

9) The landlord said to the young man, "If you do not pay your rent by evening today you will have to leave the house immediately."

- The landlord told the young man that if he did not pay the rent by that evening, he would

have to leave the house immediately.

10) His wife said to him, "Do you know that my servant stole our money?"

- His wife asked him if he knew that her servant had stolen their money.

11) Her friend said to her, "Can you spare your book for me for a week?"

- Her friend asked her if she could spare her book for her for a week.

12) She said to him, "Can I do anything for you? Will you mind my extending help to you?"

- She asked him if she could do anything for him and if he would mind her extending help to ^{him}.

13) His friend has said to him, "Did I not warn ^{you} against this beforehand?"

- His friend asked him if he had not warned him against that beforehand.

14) The captain said to the players, "Will you put your heart and soul in playing the game so that we may win the match?"

- The captain asked the players if they would put their ~~put~~ heart and soul in playing the game so that they might win the match.

15) The old man said to the child,
"Why did you break this?"

- The old man asked the child why he had broken that.
