a) Conflict in the Middle East

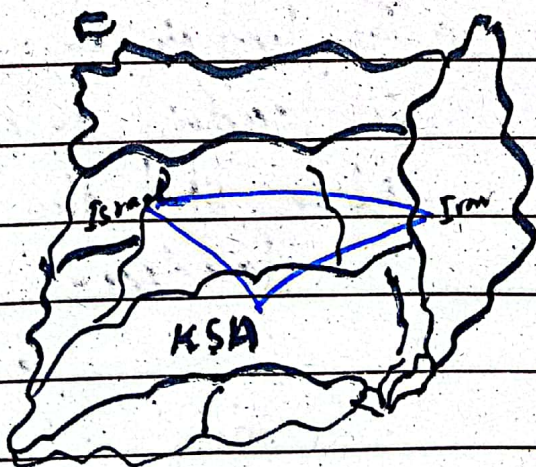
The US also leads to conflicts in the Middle East. In fact, the US is making bleak relations of KSA with Iran.
