(2) Reasons for criticism on Koyoto Protocol:
Koyoto protocal has been criticized by developed countries on following grounds:-(i) No Deadline:developed and developing countries but no developed of Completion is given. It means there is a loophole in the implentation protocol in true spirit. (ii) China in Non-Annex 1 list:-Developed countries criticized protocol regarding inclusion of China in the list of countries having no binding commitment. China contributes about 30% of global GHGs emissions, yet it is not bound to limit GHG emissions. This created a wave of resentment among developed countries. (iii) Economic Cost:-Another criticism on Koyoto Protocol is high economic costs for developed countries. As, developed countries needs to install clean projects in developing countries, it become a burden on their economies. This is the reason due to which never ratified the Koyoto Protocol.
