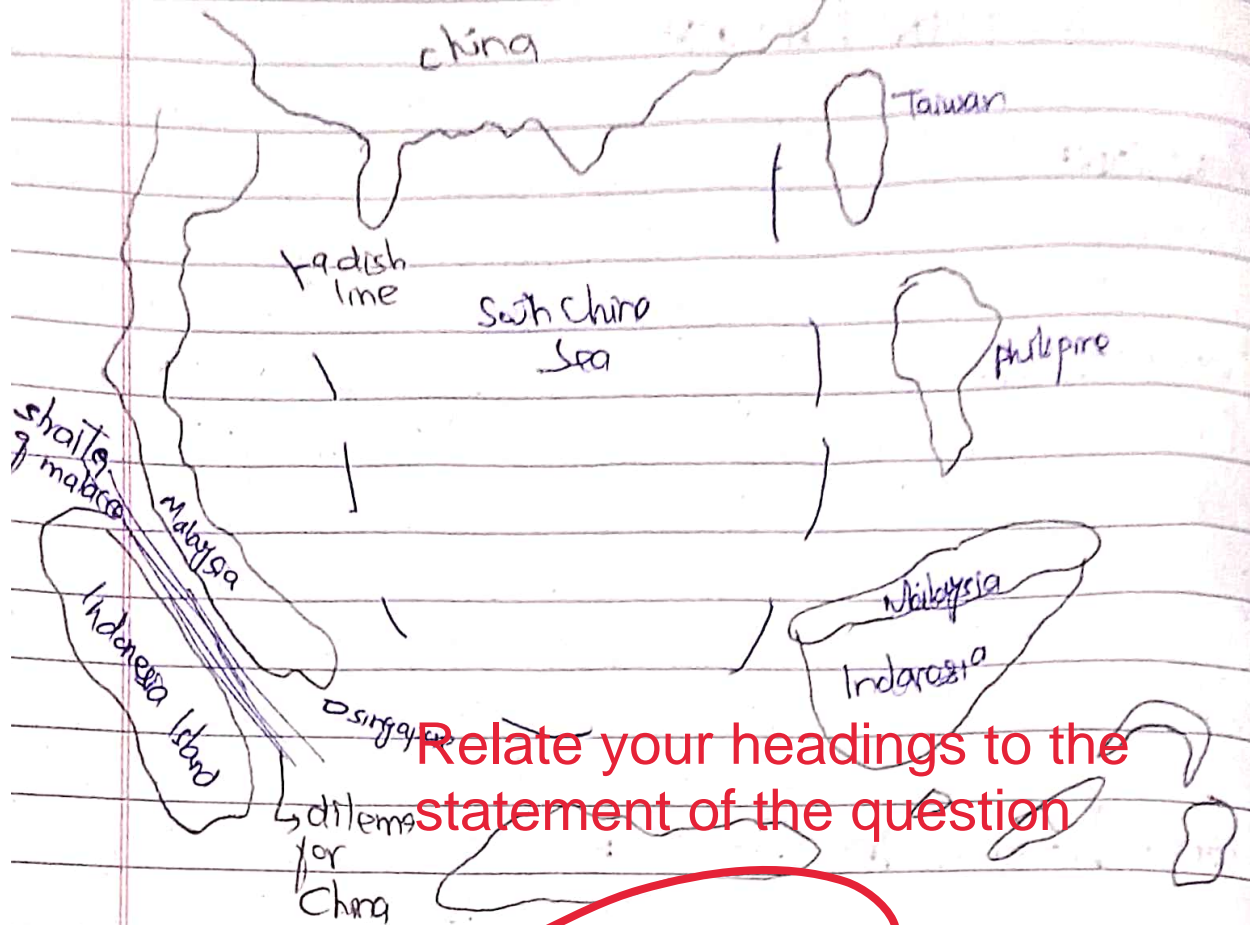

1- Short Term Projects:

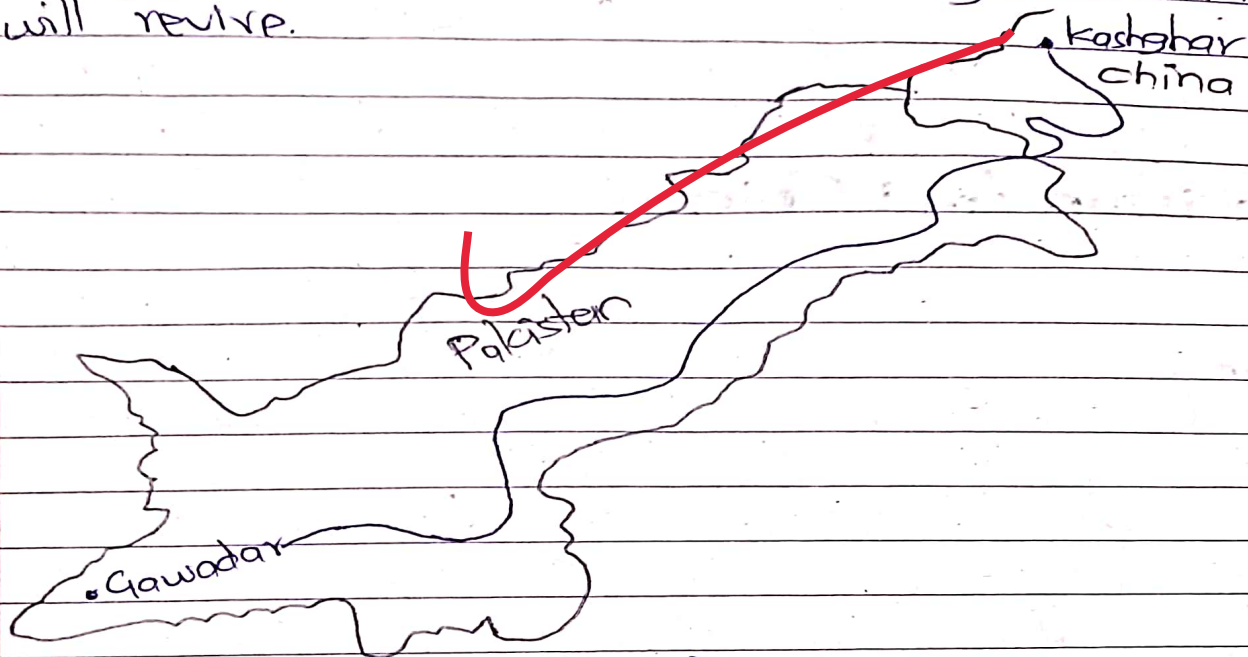
a- Investment in Infrastructure

2 Political:

~~Pakistan~~ is politically unstable at the time of emergence. There is not a single year Pakistan become political stable. Changing or dissolution of government in Pakistan is common and not a single Prime minister completed its tenure. There is no civil-military harmony in Pakistan and there is many Intra-civilian conflicts, which had adverse impact on Pakistan economy and particularly it deters potential investors.

3- Security challenge:-

There have been many security threats in the way of CPEC.

- 1- In Afghanistan emerging chaos and civil war because Kawadar part has proximity with Afghanistan
- 2- There is a threat or security threat to Chinese laborers working in CPEC projects, many got killed or injured by insurgents
- 3- Indian threat, Proxy wars and thus India is sabotaging CPEC because of India and China rivalry
- 4- Resolution of Iran's Nuclear issue, if Iran's nuclear issue is not resolve it can create a mess or chaos and conflict occurs between or Iran can initiate war with USA, which is a destabilizing factor to CPEC
- 5- There is a criticism on CPEC that China is trapping other countries on debt by their "debt trap diplomacy" is another challenge for the CPEC.
