Deen

- ① Arabic word which means to attain supremacy, dominant status.

③ Its related to spiritual as well as worldly / material things. Dr Istar Ahmed's definition of Deen says that Deen is combination of 6 things, Faith, Rituals, social functions, social system, Political and financial system, and Justice system.

④ In Shariah Deen is composed of 4 things
a- To accept sovereignty of Allah Almighty
b- To follow His commandments that is Quran
c- To follow defined rules like hudoodullah
d- To believe in reward and punishment.

5 Religion involves Allah as well as other humans. Islam is a deen it guides us social system as well. It tells us about rights of humans, animals, even environment.

6 Beliefs in Deen are God gifted or revealed. Allah said us to believe in holy books, prophets, and day of judgement.

7 Worships are also revealed. Namaz / prayer, Fasting, Zakkat, Hajj are all made obligatory by Allah.

8 Deen is super set of Religion

Holy prophet said in last sermon - Today I have complete your deen and chosen Islam for you as a deen.

Importance of Deen in Human life.

Deen is important in individual as well as in collective life. It teaches us the path of success in this world as well as here after.

① Individual's life.

a. Satisfaction of soul.
West initiated music for satisfaction of souls but they still struggle. If one's beloved dies, music won't do anything. In surah ~~Adat~~ Adat v. 28 Allah said that Allah's recitation gives peace.

b. Prevents from suicide
In West ratio of suicide is so high. In surah Nisa v. 28-29 Allah said that

At another place he mentioned that A person will never go to Jannah whose neighbor

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is unhappy due to him. In
