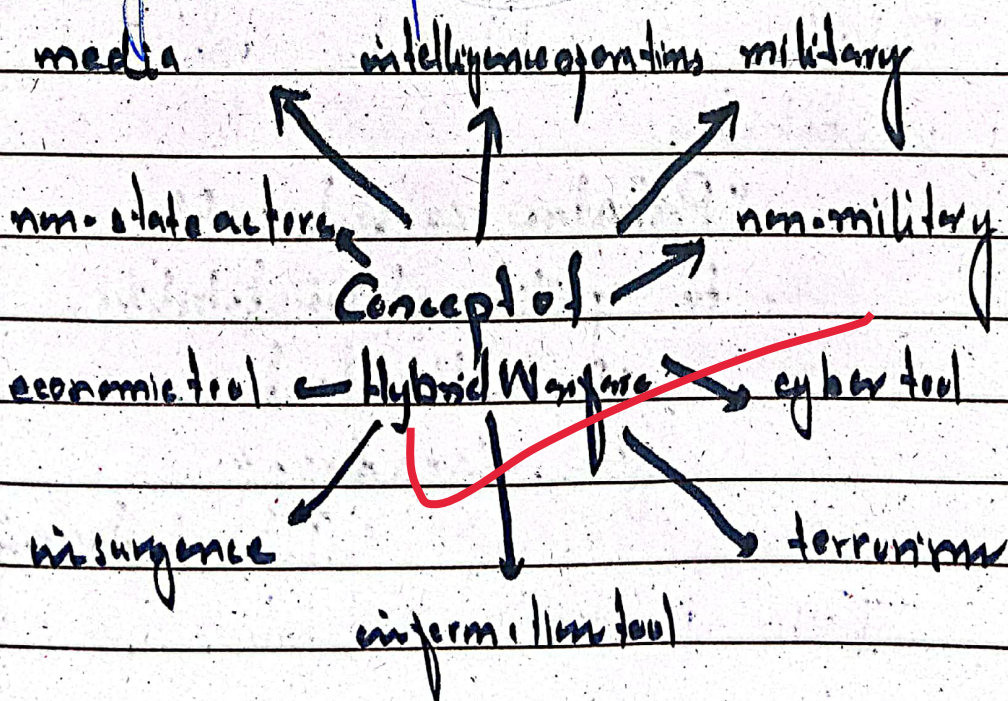

International pressure on Pakistan is relevance of Hybrid warfare. Pakistan has been accused by several threat of hybrid warfare of terrorism.

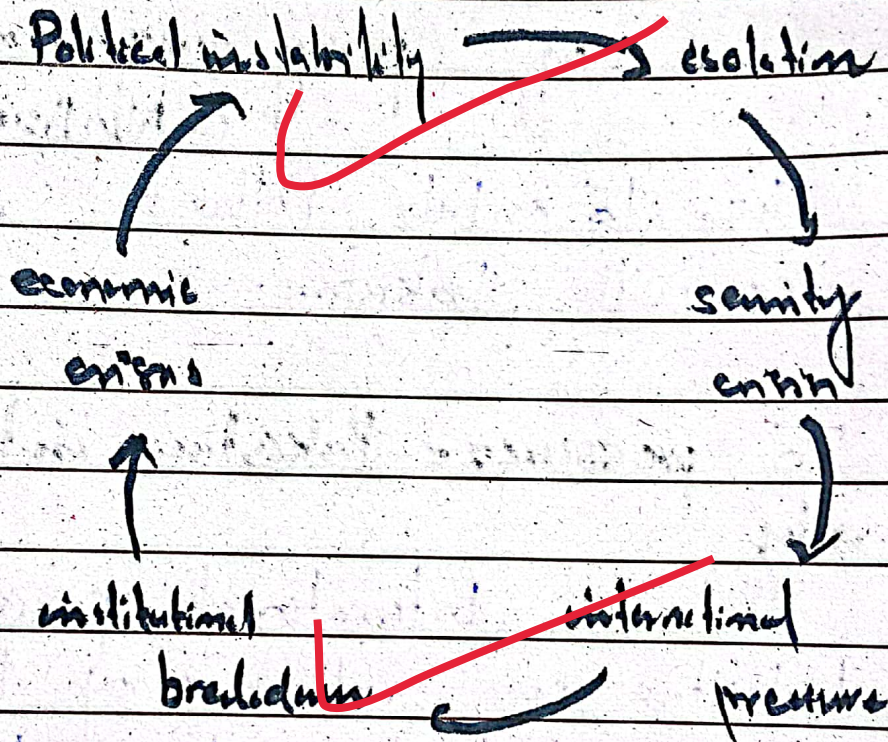

deal threat of hybrid warfare.

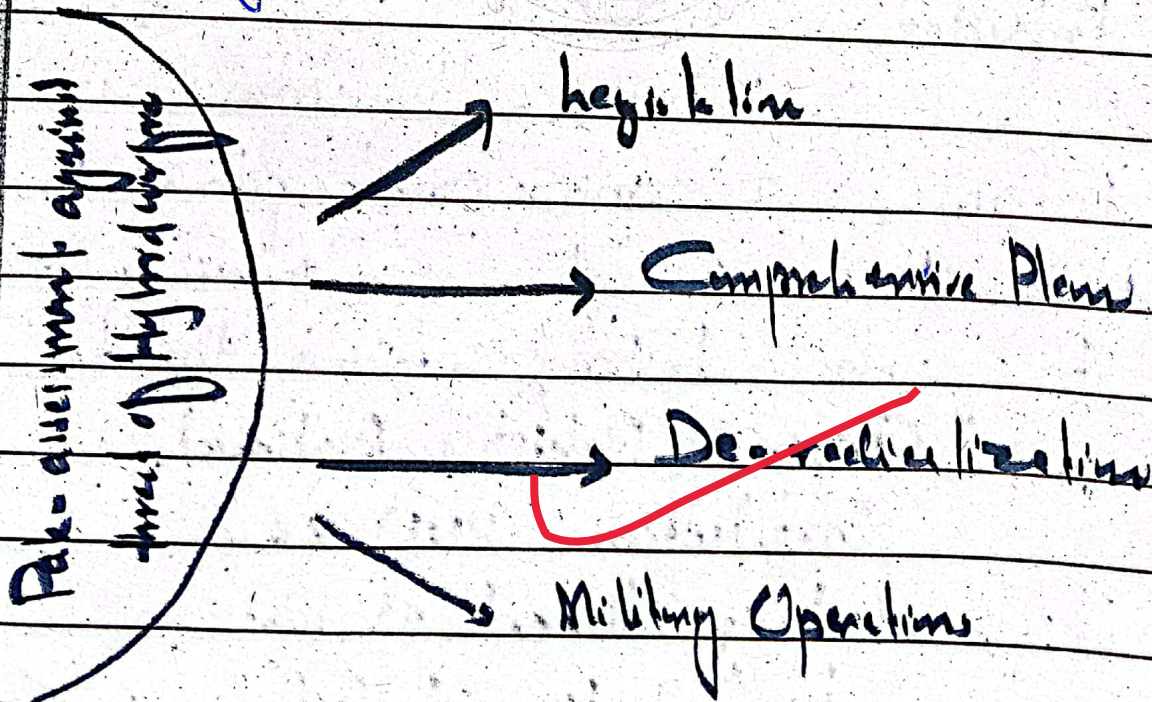
d) launched military operations against
