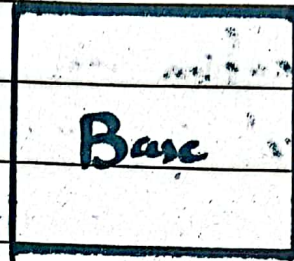
Therefore, general election of 2013 was also a base of democracy in Pakistan.

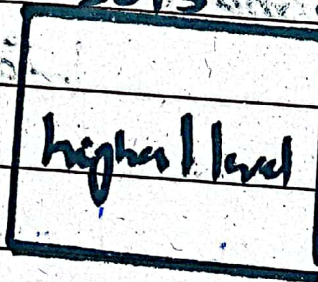
