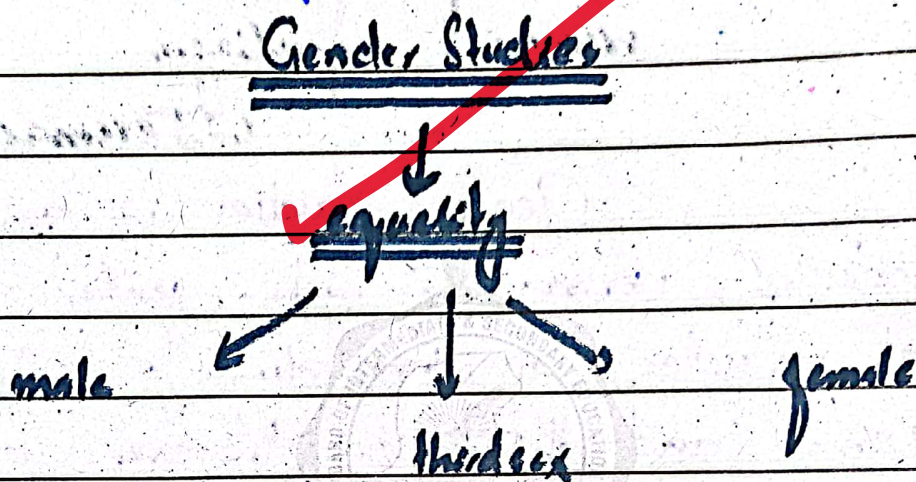

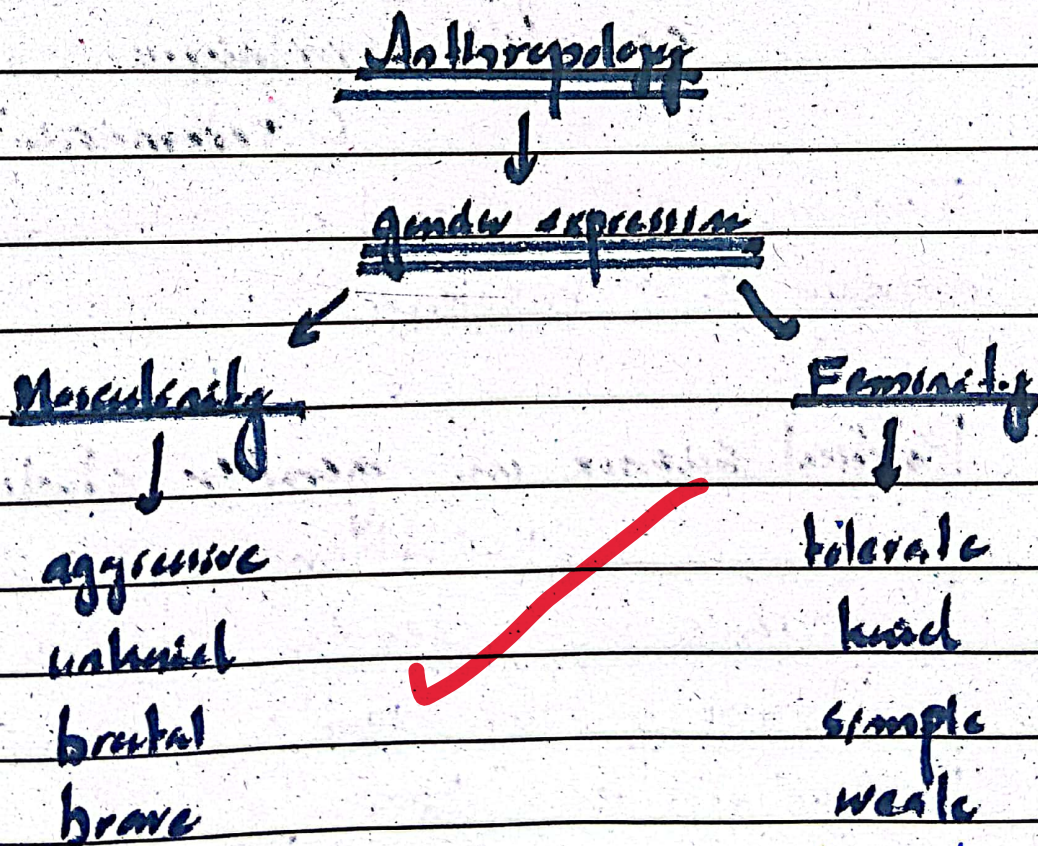
Hence, gender studies also leads

• Boys are allowed to go abroad for the higher studies, while

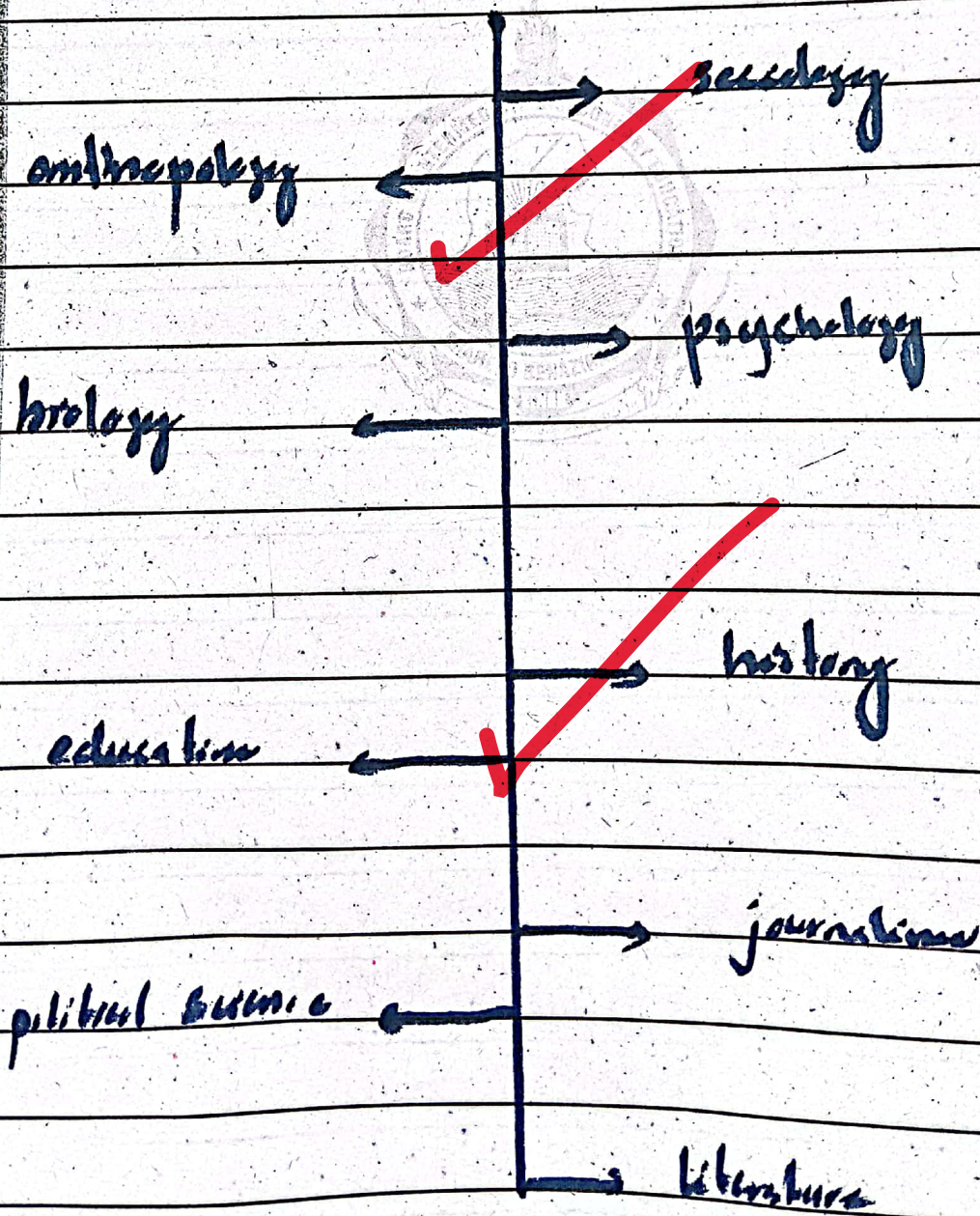


women are allowed to stay at home.
