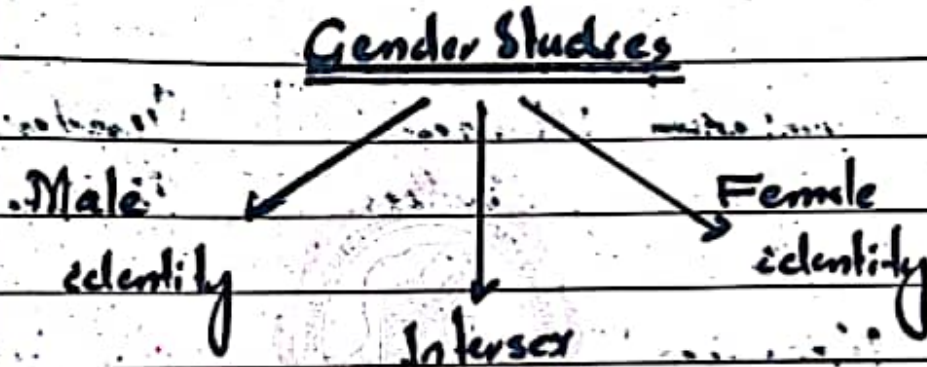

women issues. Hence, women studies is a single term field.

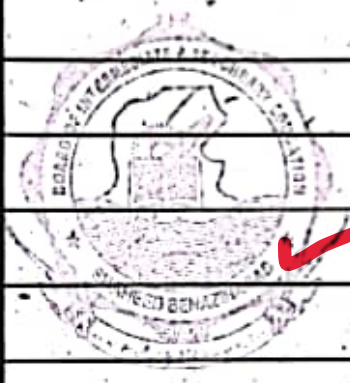
#### 4- Difference between 'Women Studies' and 'Gender Studies'
