2- The Indian National Congress: an Overview

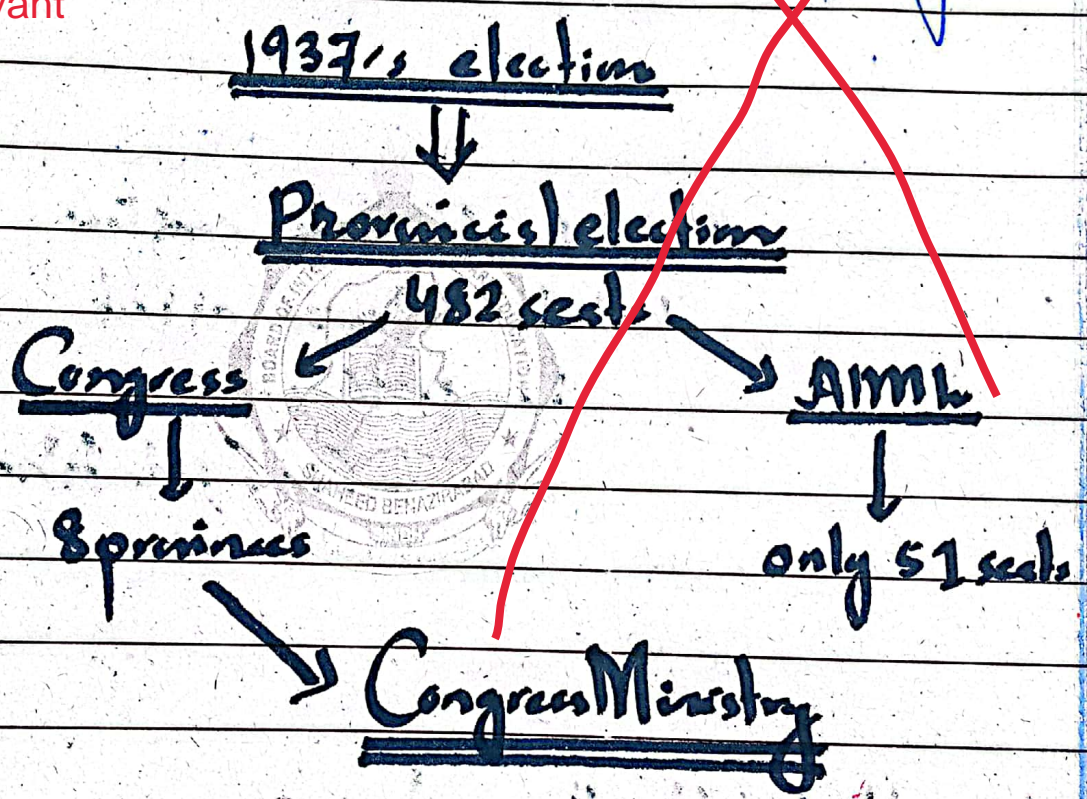
"1937's election gave birth to the

Following were reasons:



a) Congress: the threat to AIML
 "Congress Ministry
 wanted to cripple
 AIML."

(- Raza Rabbani)

Congress ministry was a
 great threat to Muslim League.
 In fact, an attempt of Congress
 was to put down AIML.

"Hindu-Muslim conflict
 led to adverse effect
 to AIML."

(- Sir Syed Ahmad)

Therefore, Sir Syed opposed the
 Congress.

b) Urdu-Hindi controversy:

Moreover, Congress also
 wanted to suppress Urdu. How-
 ever it was an official language
 in 1825.

"Congress attempted
 to devalue Urdu."

(-Razvi Rabhani)

Resultantly, Sir Syed started movement in protection of Urdu.

"Maulana Abul-Kalam

Azad led to Anjuman

-e-Urdu."

Therefore, Sir Syed opposed Congress.

c) Threat to Muslim culture and interest

Further, Congress posed threat to Muslim culture. In fact, Muslims' freedom was compromised.

Hence, Sir Syed strongly opposed Congress.



d) Banned Religious Liberty

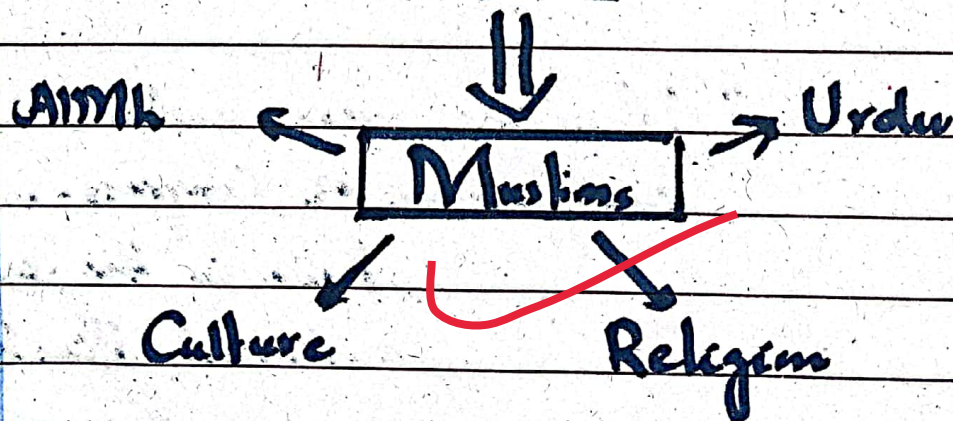
Further more, Muslims were not free in religion. In fact, ~~Congress~~ made religious liberty ~~Banned~~ for Muslims.

4- Sir Syed Ahmed's successful ideology

Following are successful attempts:

a) No trust on Hindus: Rebellion of Hind

Sir Syed Ahmed noticed Hindus are not trustworthy. He encouraged Muslims not to trust on Hindus.

"In 1859, he wrote a book 'Asbab-e-Baqwat-e-Hind' means, causes of Indian revolt..."

Sir Syed Ahmed encouraged Muslims by written words.

b) Unity among Muslims: Active participation in politics

"Muslims should take active part in politics."

(- Sir Syed Ahmed)



Sir Syed encouraged Muslims in politics. In fact, he pushed them to separate their paths from Hindus. Hence, Sir Syed was a successful leader.

c) Bi-nations: Two Nation Theory

"Hindu and Muslims
can not live together"

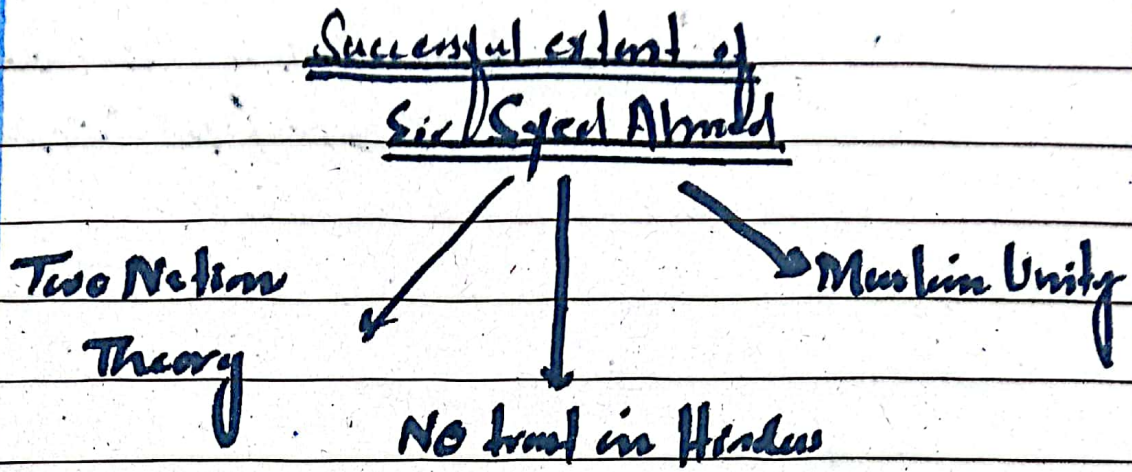
(- Sir Syed Ahmed)
