2. Life of Sir Syed Ahmed (1817-1898) : an Overview.

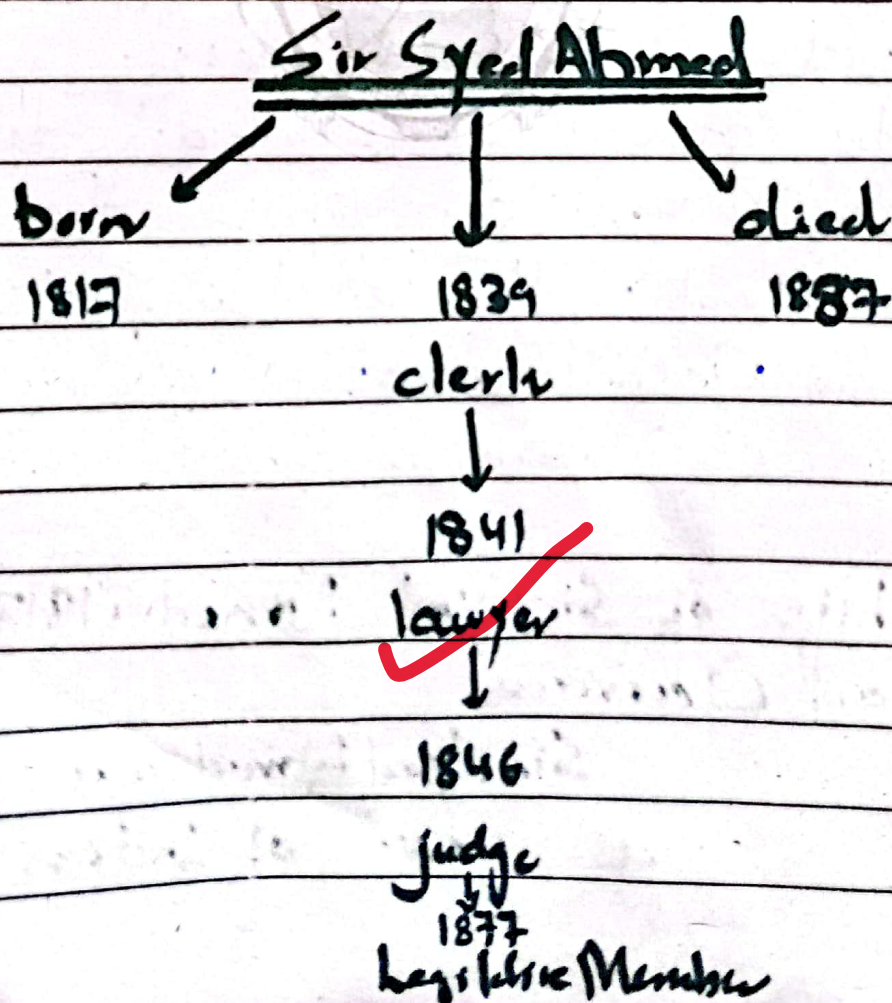

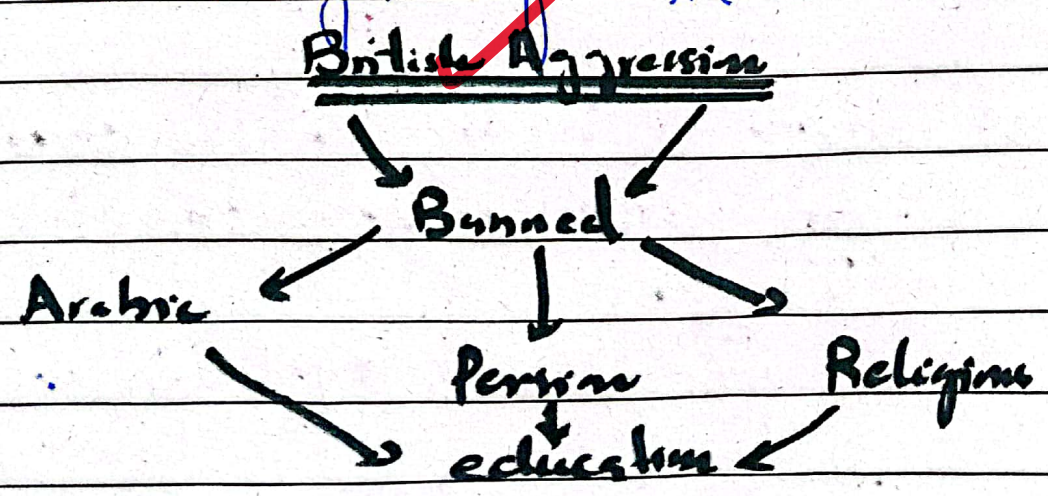
Sir Syed Ahmed Khan

Sir Syed Ahmed saw the aggression of the British in India. The British government made English an official language in 1835. Moreover, after the war of independence of 1857, the British banned Arabic, Persian, and religious education. Therefore, Sir Syed Ahmed realized the need of modern system for Muslims.



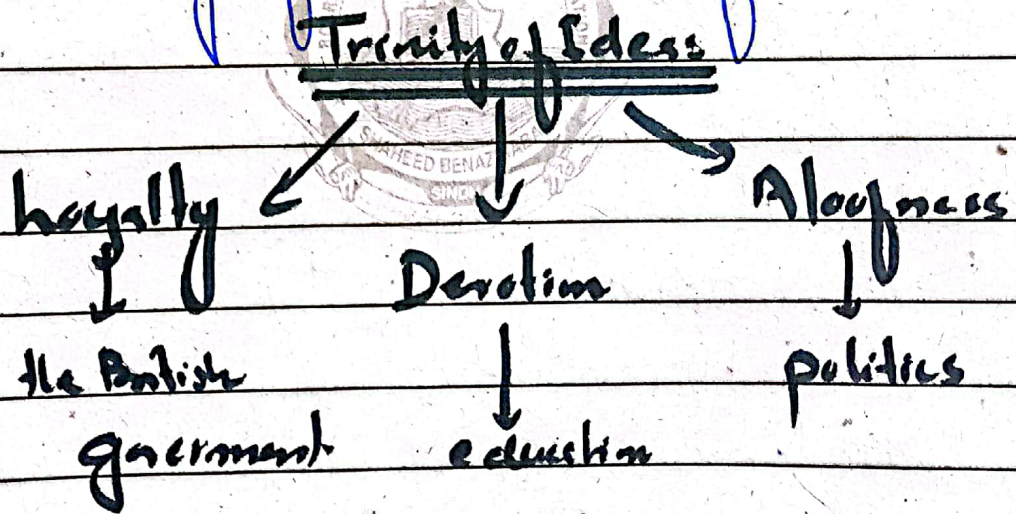


4- Sir Syed Ahmed's 'Trinity of edess'

a) loyalty to the British government with respect to Al's Gurb Movement

Sir Syed Ahmed rep-

resented loyalty with the British.
Sir Syed Ahmed wanted to decrease
the British aggression towards Mus-
lims.

Ali Grah Movement.

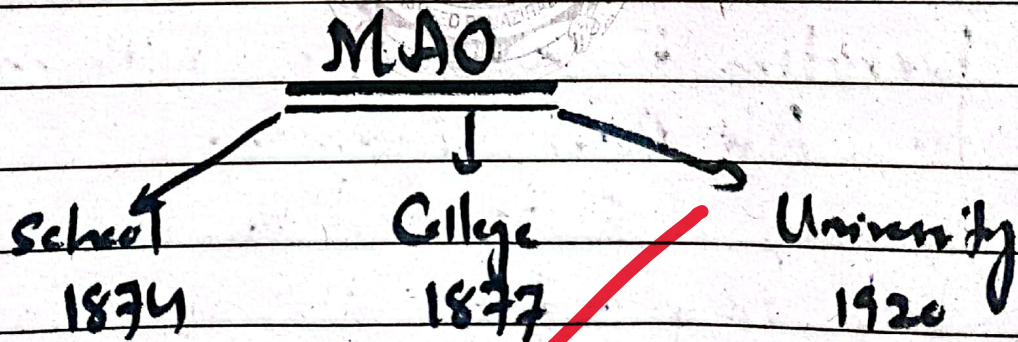
"Muslims must seek

c) Aloofness from politics with respect to Ali Quli Movement
