

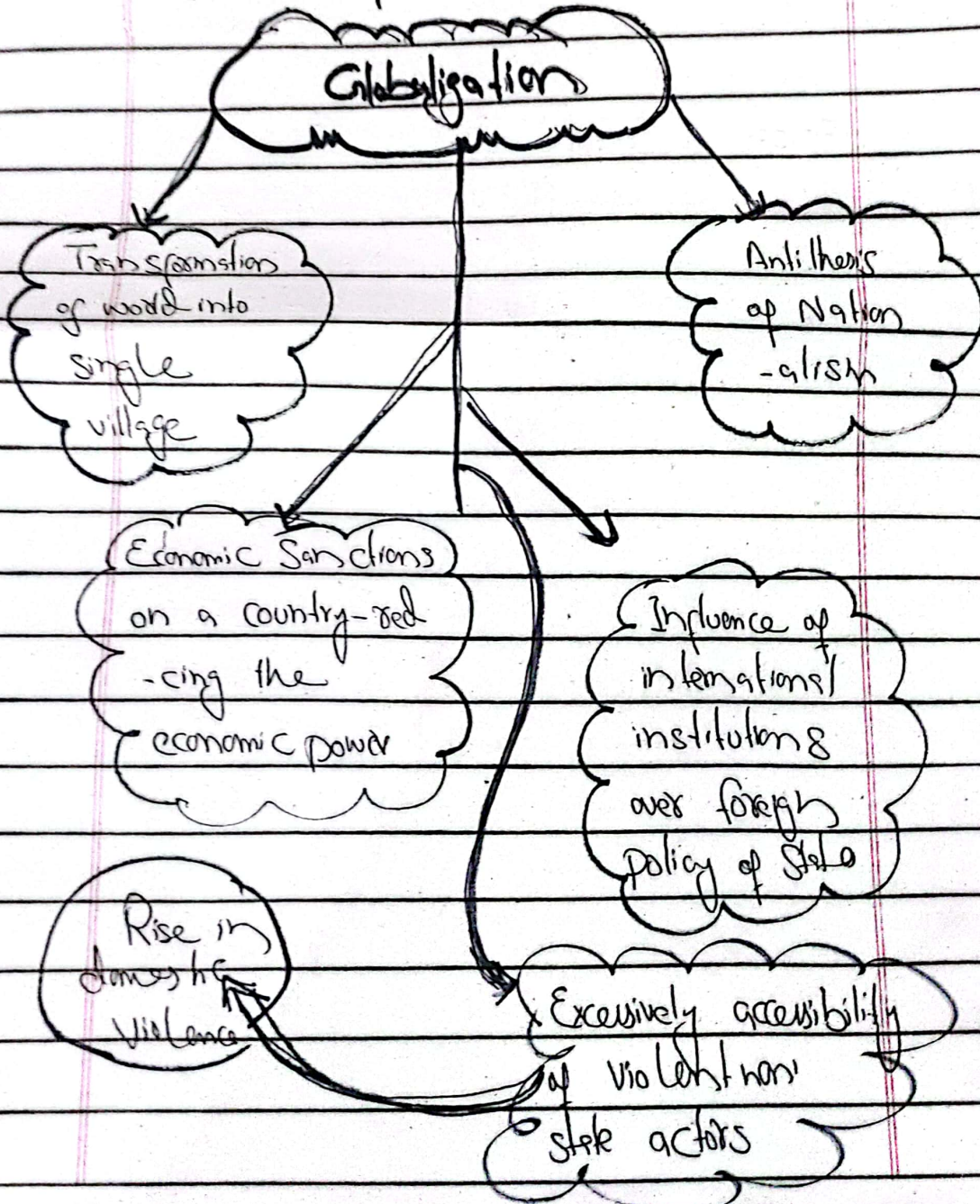

The use of Indian soft power in Pakistan, for cultural merging is also noted

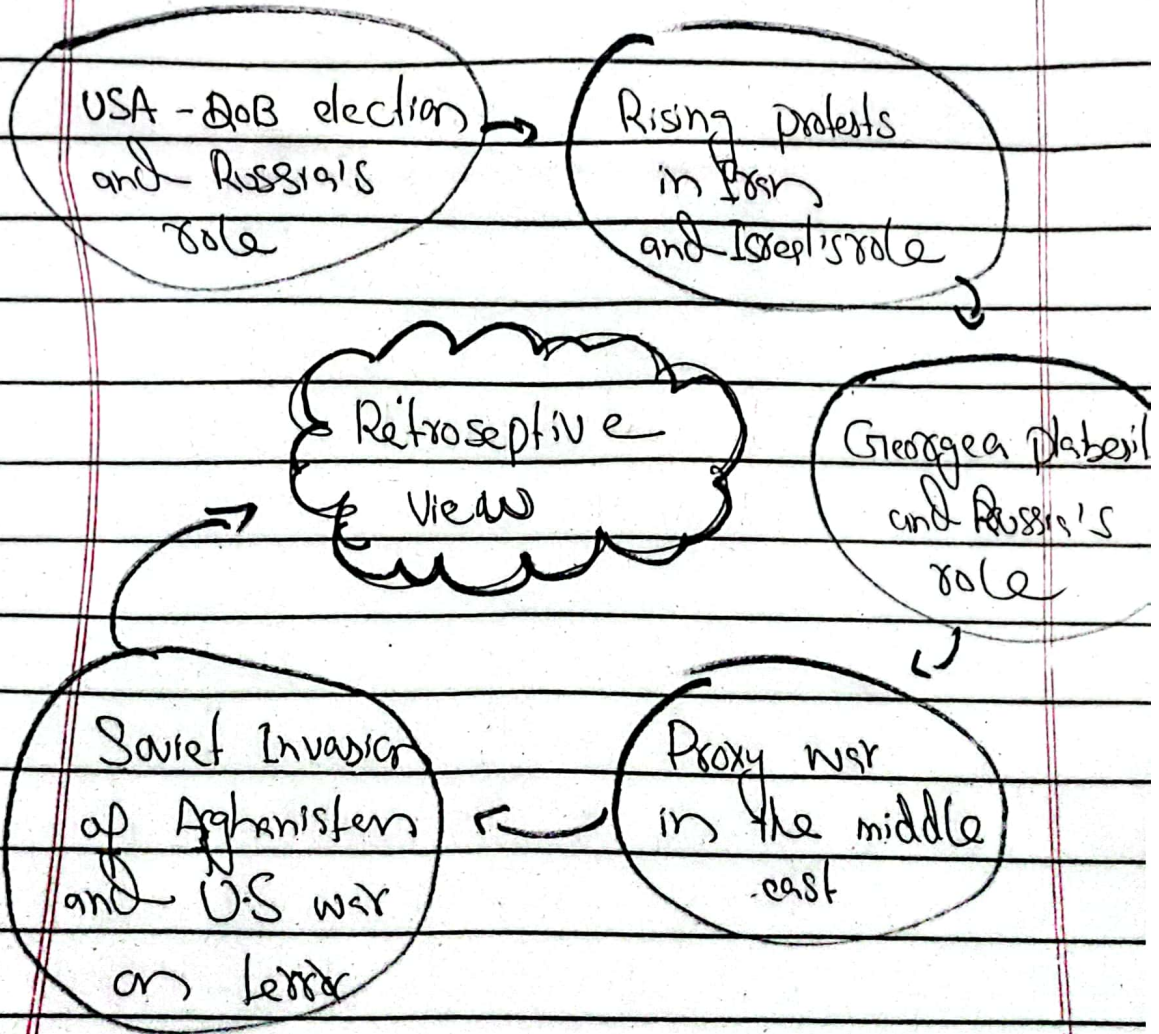
4.5- Alliances - Power to minimize the power to antagonist political parties
