

ANTICIPATION OF ART:

From Plato to Tolstoy, art has been blamed of triggering human's sentiments eventually leading to disharmony of values. Tolstoy sees art as, mere mode of infection. Similarly, the audience of art is not infected by the traits of the characters. However, the audience sees through them and instills the significance of traits. Hence, Shakespeares ideology corresponds with the exemplary artists of fine arts.

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
