What is difference between Deen and Religion? Describe the importance of Deen in human life with Arguments.

DEEN AND RELIGION

Deen and Religion (Mazhab) are two aspects of life of humans and they used interchangeably while discussing about the code of life given by Allah.

RELIGION (Mazhab):

Religion (Mazhab) is a word which refers to the set of rituals, beliefs, and social customs given by Allah Almighty. It majorly focuses on the individual life - that how he may lead by following - the orders of Allah. However Religion may refer to Islam, Christianity, Judaism etc but with narrow perspective and it

Difference between Deen and Mazhab :

Area of Perspective:
