Negation and delay election process

Polarized politics has challenges to democracy in Pakistan, chief among them is negation and delay election process. Growing political polarization has also delayed election process recently. "After the vote of no-confidence passing against premier, Imran Khan, election in Punjab and KPK was delayed." (Pew Research Centre, 2023). This shows how polarized politics leads to a challenge to democracy as delay election process.

Not only this, but lack of accountability in all tiers of government has also become a challenge to democracy in Pakistan. No doubt, polarized politics has threatened the country's accountability mechanism for political interests, rather than, democratic norms. As a result, Pakistan has shaped in a bad image regarding accountability at global level. As per report, "Pakistan ranks 140th out of 180 countries in accountability perception."
