In these words of Kofi Annan, religious extremism refers to radical interpretation of religious principles which threatens economic development and national integrity. There are multiple factors which trigger religious extremism but lack of professional religious leaders, globalization and biased policies of major powers are most important among them. The fundamentalist ideologies bring forth various challenges to economic expansion. These include instability, delay in economical development and serious damage to infrastructure. In addition, it impedes investments, promotes gender discrimination and cause loss to tourism sector. Furthermore, the rigid

mindset resist. Scientific advancement, modern economic system and advance health care facilities. Although, religious extremism. Seriously affect economic growth, still, a few measures would be helpful to restrain ~~religious~~ ~~extremism~~. fundamentalist ideologies.

These include the introduction of single national curriculum and potent policy formulation. Religious extremism has a  
grave consequences on economic  
development. It promotes instability  
which in turn halt economic  
activities in a country. The delayed  
economic projects cause huge  
damage to economy. People with  
rigid mindset instigate crowd on  
minor issues and cause damage  
to infrastructure. Almost every  
country around the glob directly  
or indirectly confronting with this  
menace. The countries like Pakistan,  
Afghanistan, Nigeria, <sup>Somalia</sup> and  
many other have lost billions of  
dollar and millions of human  
resource due to this threat. There-  
fore, religious extremism is a  
serious challenge for economic  
development.

There are multiple factors which trigger religious extremism. Lack of professional religious leaders is most important among them. Religious leaders are most valuable asset of any religion. They are greatly followed and respected by people. A single misinterpretation of religious tenets by these guides could lead a brutal violence in the society. Therefore, professional religious leader <sup>are necessary to</sup> ~~should be~~ directed the people in right direction. For example due to misconception of "Jihad" among Muslim community several extremist groups <sup>have</sup> ~~are~~ formed. The Tehreek Taliban Pakistan is one of those groups. Hence, lack of professional religious leaders lead to religious extremism.

Similarly, globalization and lack of tolerance among haves and have-nots also promote

religious extremism. Globalisation has transformed the world into a global village. In this ~~village~~ smaller hamlet distribution of resources is not uniform.

Some people are living luxurious life with all the facilities of ~~life~~ living.

The other group despite great hard work forced to spend miserable time.

This unequal distribution division of means arise a feeling of hatred.

They express such emotions in the form of religious extremism. The perceived injustice compel individuals to adhere radical ideology which in turn comes out in the form of religious extremism (Cas Muddle, why some people choose the path of violence, 2017)

Thus, ~~globalization~~ globalisation and lack of tolerance among haves and have-nots foster religious extremism.

Furthermore, Unjustifiable policies of major powers coerced people toward radical beliefs. Major

powers, which share the control of ~~the~~  
entire world play a vital role in all <sup>global</sup> ~~domestic~~  
issues. They set principles and prepare  
policies for ~~the~~ rest <sup>of the</sup> countries. They  
formulate and implement those  
procedures across the globe. The behaviour  
of such authorities creates turmoil  
among individuals. This disturbance  
intensifies with time and takes the  
shape of religious extremism. For example  
the unjustifiable hegemonic intervention  
of United States in internal affairs  
of countries in the name of promoting  
democracy and protection of human  
rights instigate violence. This behavior  
of interference is illegal according  
to Article-5 of UN charter. United  
States being the major power force  
other to abide this policy while she  
herself ignore it. Therefore, unjustifiable  
policies of major powers give birth to  
religious extremism.

Above all, religious extremism  
is a challenge for economic development.  
It causes delay in economic expansion  
projects. The stretched schedules of  
monetary activities make fragile  
economy. The fundamentalist provoke  
minor issues and make them a  
national concern. The nation react  
<sup>thus the</sup>  
and peace of the country become  
compromise. The chaotic condition  
of the region do not let the project  
to be completed in their due  
time. For example the delay in  
CPEC projects in Pakistan due to  
turmoil inside the country greatly  
affected its economy. The projects  
which were supposed to be finished  
in 2018 took two more years. The  
Thar coal power project got ~~1~~  
Three extra annum, and became functional  
in 2023. The reason was disorder in  
Balochistan. Thus religious extremism  
cause delay in economic projects.

Furthermore, extremist ideology causes damage to infrastructure. The people who adhere extreme principles regarding religion do not accept other's opinion. The points which do not resemble with their beliefs is against religion according to them. This conservative mindset compel them to be in the mode of violence all the time. They forget the peace on minor issues. Those people harm all the assets of the state in aggression including infrastructure. The TTP group believes that everyone who is not under the umbrella of Islam, be titled with death (Amina Khan, Guardian of God, 2018). Thus, religious extremism cause damage to infrastructures.

In addition, religious extremism hinder internal as well as external investments. The instability created due to religious extremism impede investor to

choose that particular country for fund allocation. Moreover, the financiers who are the resident of the state leave the country in search of suitable regions. When the process of financial commitment gets disturbed the graph of economy abruptly goes down. Therefore, extremism severely affect economy. Muhammad Zarkaria <sup>in his</sup> writes in his article **Effect of terrorism on economic growth in Pakistan**. writes, one percent increase in terrorism reduces FDI by 0.104 percent domestic investment by 0.0089 percent and economic growth by 0.02 percent. This means religious extremism has a direct effect on investments. In a nutshell, religious extremism hinders internal as well as external investments.

Moreover, radical religious beliefs threat the tourism sector. Tourism ~~goal~~ entails movement of

the people inside a country and earn currency for the state. People from various part of the world visit region for joy and on purpose. For this purpose they prefer those areas which are either beautiful or have some history behind. When such territory comes under the influence of religious extremism its peace gets compromised.

This chaotic situation force the tourist to go for an choice. Tourism is an organized activity in Maldives.

Since 1972, it forms 28 percent of its total GDP. The male sultan Park bomb blast in 2007 produced serious security threats to <sup>tourism</sup> ~~tourist~~. After this blast various countries canceled their bookings and this sector faced huge loss. (UNISCI Discussion Paper). Hence religious extremism cause a serious threat to tourism sector.

Additionally, fundamentalist ideologies resist scientific advancements. <sup>Empirical</sup> ~~gradual~~ ~~type~~ development plays a vital role in the improvement of economy. It introduces innovative ideas and modern machineries to increase the productivity of industries. Whereas extremists regard it ~~as~~ against nature and create misconception among people.

The lack of knowledge about religion and the systematic study compel people to reject this progress. According to a research conducted by PEW RESEARCH CENTER of US the countries with extremist beliefs still strive with scientific advancement and face severe economic problems. Hence, radical ideologies impede scientific advancement.

Furthermore, the rigid mindset about the modern economic system restrains expansion of economy. People with conservative

religious believers reject advanced business techniques. They declare certain trade methods as forbidden in the religion.

~~between countries~~ These people not only reject such ideas but also force others. In this way economic

growth suffer greatly. For example religious extremists say taking profit is forbidden in religion. Keeping this point in mind they do not invest their money and do not contribute in the escalation of economy. Therefore the rigid mindset about the modern economic system impede economic expansion.

Besides, radical ideologies promote instability inside a country which divert the priorities of policy makers. In a country where peace become top desire other need ~~to~~ <sup>get</sup> compromised. The chaotic situation in the state sticks policy makers

concentration in one point which is security. In this condition economic progress face a temporary break. This way disorder condition restrain economic expansion. For example Swat terrorist attack in 2012 restrained all the developmental work in the region. The attention of policy maker only remain stucked to security concerns. Therefore, religious extremism foster instability due to which economic expansion halt temporarily.

Despite severe religious extremism some measures could be helpful to restrain religious extremism and widen the way for economic development. The

introduction of single curriculum for all sorts of education system is most important among them. The difference in ideas occurs due to the way students are

been taught. Some students get western education via elite education systems. The others received madrasa based education with outdated curriculum. When the two come face to face they present conflict of ideas which foster extremism. In case single curriculum implemented in all educational institutes it would mitigate all kinds of fanatic ideologies.

Furthermore, strong policy formulation regarding extremists and extremist institutions would impede radical ideologies. All those people who are responsible for brain washing youth in the name of religion must be brought in state notice.

Moreover, the provision of professional religious leader is state's responsibility.

Government select even a primary teacher after several procedure but

criteria. The expert pious guides guide the people in right direction.

A person with misundertood knowledge of religion can spread violence and aggression among people. Hence, state should understand its role and set some qualifying method for the selection of religious leaders.

Last but not the least, upgradation of curriculum according to the need of the time would contribute towards escalating economy. The current course program is outdated and do not meet the requirement of the modern world. The integration of advance knowledge in study material would increase student interest. The involvement of students in studies would impede them to follow any extremist ideology.

In this way radical thought would be restrained and the way economic expansion would be widen.

In a nutshell, religious extremism is a serious challenge for economic development.
