- (a) It is the ability of superpowers to end any conflict around the world through resolution.

3. Retrospective analysis of the roles of superpowers in making choices of Peace:

- ① The formation of multilateral and collective security organization by superpowers in form of United Nations to make or ensure peaceful co-existence.
- ② Cuban Missile Crisis - 1962; a choice of peace made by superpowers.
- ③ The peaceful end of cold war in 1991 was also a choice of superpowers.

- (d) Various accords on Palestine issue mark as a choice of peace by Super powers; David camp accord 1978, Abraham Accord - 2020.
- (e) Sanctions made over South Korea to end military aggrandizement.
- (f) Iran nuclear deal to end nuclear proliferation; by aiming to make world safe.
- (g) Minsk agreement in 2015 to end Ukraine crisis.
- (h) USA withdrawal from Afghanistan after two decades.
- (i) Constant diplomatic efforts in middle east, central Asia, Europe, and in Taiwan issue to ensure peace over war.

4- Retrospective Analysis of the role of Superpowers in making choices of War:

- (a) USA intervention in Iraq war 2003 - 2011; over fake allegations to eradicate weapons of mass destructions.
- (b) choices of war made by super powers

during cold war era; Vietnam war 1955-74,
Soviet invasion of Afghanistan 1979-89, and
invasion of Panama Canal 1989.

- ② U.S bombing of Yugoslavia in 1999 to end genocide.
- (d) U.S occupation of Afghanistan in 2001 to fight war on terror.
- ③ Russia annexation of Crimea in 2014 by force.
- (f) Russian invasion of Ukraine in 2022 over territorial concerns.
- (g) Palestine and Israel war in 2023 escalated by USA.
- (h) Concerns over UNSC in making choices of war over peace; Ukraine war, Palestine war.
