

Introduction: The political system of US has prominent feature of "Separation of power". All the organs of government are not dependent of each other like the political system of UK and Pakistan Hower, the American constitution has not provided the clean severance to all three organs. To weaken the authority, fathers of constitutions have introduced checks and balances. So, that one organ can interest the misuse of power of others Legislatures have some powers to obstruct the orders of Executive and same like that Judiciary have powers to veto any law or ordinance. System of separation of powers: In the US political system, all institutes have separate

powers, they are not dependent on each other. There is no other constitution where powers are so clear. Like other constitutions in the world, UK's parliant is dependent on Prime Minister, he can dissolve it and vice versa House of Commons can pass vote of no confidence against PM. But in US, both organs are independent, however, Senate can impeach Pseside by some allegations and placess.
