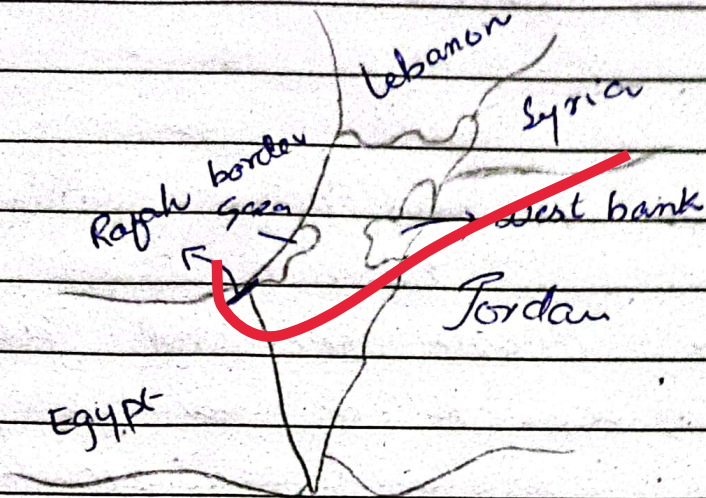

## ii) Outright Blockade - Threatening the Indigenous' lives:

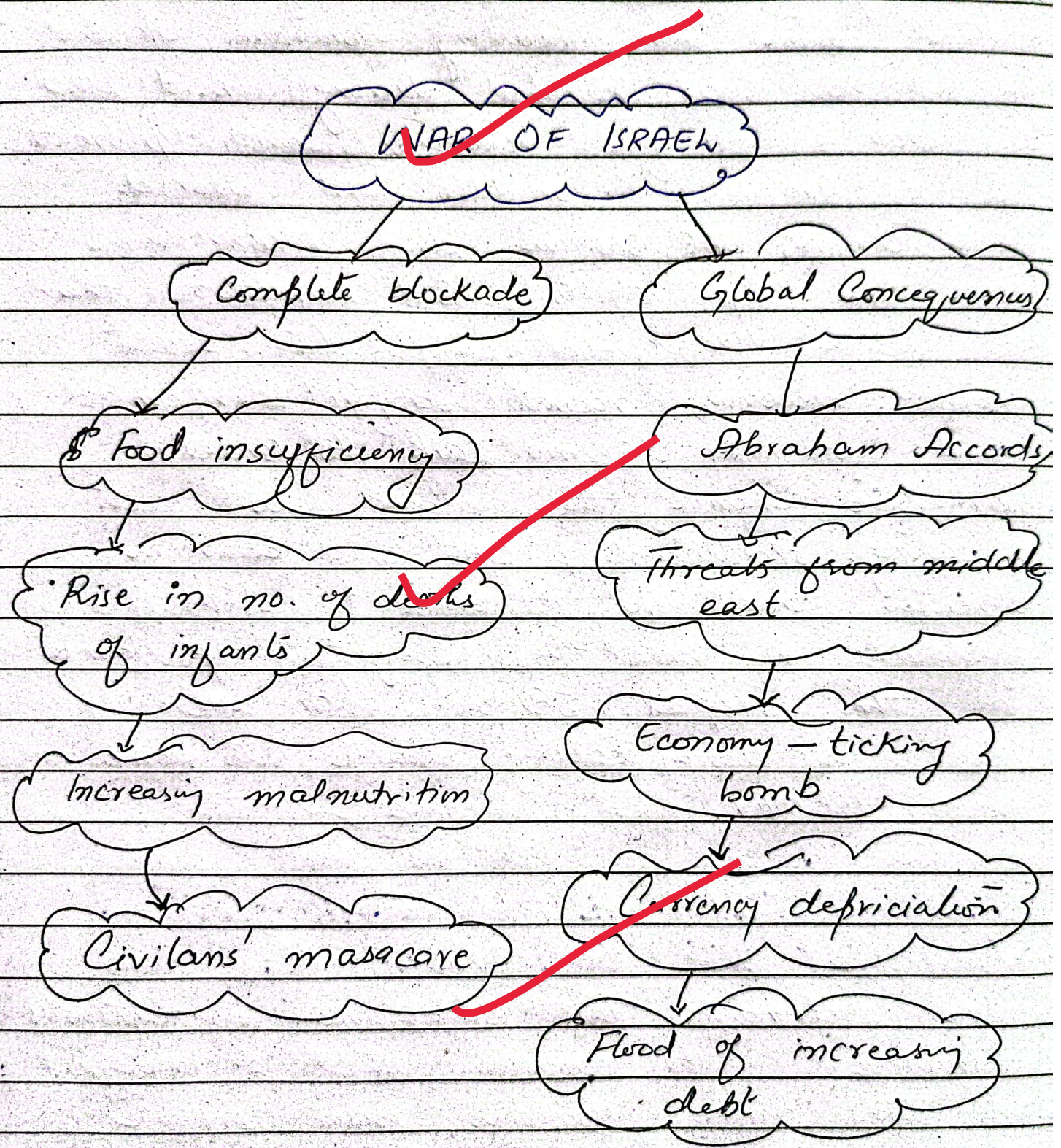

### iii) DETERIORATION OF ARAB-ISRAEL RELATIONS - DECAYING ABRAHAM ACCORD

The biggest break through during the crucial time was halting Abraham Accord. The accord was launched during mid 2020 to promote peaceful relations and diplomatic ties of Israel with middle east world. Qatar, Oman, UAE, Bahrain and Morocco were the top states to normalize their ties with Israel, accepting its state notion. However, recent conflict influenced Saudi Arabia to no talk to Israel narrative, hence the accord lost its swing. Additionally, UAE and Bahrain threaten Israel if it doesnot stop genocide in Gaza, they might help Hamas in this respect. Jordan has already part its ties by calling back its ambassador from Tel Aviv.

### iv) BENEFITTING IRAN'S NARRATIVE - AGAINST US AND ISRAEL:

Iran during this scenario continuously announced its economic and technological aid to Hamas. However, Iran since begining of its revolution possessed anti US and Israel narrative got the



most benefit upon upholding the Abraham Accord. It has never been a strategic ally to Israel or US. Thus, appreciated Saudi "no talk" agenda after mass destruction and apprehension of civilians.

## v) EXPOURE OF BIASED STANDARD FROM US AND ALLIES

USA while supporting Ukraine's idea of free will and issuing red warrant against Vladimir Putin from International Court of Justice — ~~are~~ unable to see Gaza. By overlooking the genocide, US and its allies are facing allegations of biased standard, followed by gigantic protests in their own states, against Israel. During security Council session UAE presented the resolution for immediate ceasefire in Gaza, 13 out of 15 countries voted in favour. While, UK abstained and US has vetoed the resolution — proving biased decision or hijacked institution run by US not the world.



## vi) GROWING INFLUENCE OF CHINA IN MIDDLE EAST - ECONOMICALLY AND POLITICALLY

During the conflict of Israel - Hamas, China gained unanimous importance and diplomatic support from the globe.
