Narration

In English language, the act of reporting to words is called narration or reported speech.

Two way of speak narration are direct to indirect.

Direct Sentence :-

- The landlord said to the young man, "If you do not pay your rent by evening today you will have to leave the house immediately."

Indirect Sentence :-

The landlord ^{went} told the young man that if he ~~did~~ ^{would} not pay ~~you~~ ^{his} rent by evening ~~today~~ ^{that day} ~~you~~ ^{he} ~~will~~ ^{would} have to leave the house immediately.

Direct Sentence :-

His wife said to him, "Do you know that my servant stole our ~~money~~ money?"

Indirect Sentence :-

His wife told he that ~~he~~ ^{if} he know that my servant stole our money.

his wife asked him if he know that her husband had stolen their money

Direct Sentence :-

Her friend said to her, "Can you spare your book for me for a week?"

Indirect Sentence :-

Her friend told her that he spare ~~his~~ book for me for a week.

Direct Sentence :-

She said to him, "Can I do anything for you? Will you mind my extending help to you?"

Indirect Sentence :-

She told ^{him} that he ~~do~~ anything for he would he mind my extending help to you.

Direct Sentence :-

His friend said to him, "Did I not warn you against this beforehand?"

Indirect Sentence :-

His friend told him that he warned against ~~that~~ beforehand.

Direct Sentence:

The Captain said to the players, "Will you put your heart and soul in playing the game so that we may win the match?"

Indirect Sentence:

The Captain told the players that would he put his heart and soul in playing the game so that we may win the match.
