5- Indoctrination against opposite ideologies.

a- Human always opposing the heterogeneity related to existence of ideologies (Socrates, Heraclitus)

b- Cognitive Dissonance creates fear of being misled and suppressed, so subsequently opposing persecuted those existing beliefs. (The Salem witch Trials, 1692)

a - Fundamentalists relentlessly picking the limelight (The Reconquista in Spain)
