Answer 1. Introduction.

Niccolo Machiavelli was a fifteenth century philosopher. He was born in Italy. He is known as the father of modern politics and as well as the father of power politics. Among his major works "The Prince" is the most popular.

2. Machiavelli's concept of Power Politics.

Immoral Means to achieve end (state) through Power Politics.

a) Fox and Lion

Machiavelli gave the idea that in order to maintain power, Monarch should be brave like lion and cunning like a fox. In this he can perform better to control power.

b) - cruelty of Monarch.

According to him monarch should be cruel. He must show his power to terrify the masses. He should use his power at once to create the fear. So that no one could revolt against him.

c) - No Right of Revolt.

a). Form of Government.

e) - Strong Army.

Monarch should develop strong army and navy so that it can protect state. He should increase them in numbers. In this way he can maintain security and power.
