→ She told him that she was leaving ^{then} now and should return after two hours.

③ The girl said to me, "My father went to the market and brought toys for me."

→ The girl told me that her father had gone to the market and ~~brought~~ toys for her.

④ Her husband said to her, "I shall not go to the office today as I am not feeling well."

→ Her husband told her that she should not go to the office today as she was not feeling well. ^{that day}.

⑤ My father has said to me, "I fear that you have caught cold again."

→ My father ~~has~~ told me ^{that} that he fear ^{ed} that I have ~~caught~~ cold again.

⑥ His brother said to me, "I am not going to attend the meeting today."

→ His brother told me that he ~~was~~ not going to attend the meeting that day.

⑦ The inspector said to the people, "We have caught the thief, and he will be brought to book soon."

→ The inspector told the people that they had caught the thief and he would be brought to book soon.

⑧ The lady has said to her husband, "Whether you agree with me or not I am not going to change my decision."

→ The lady ~~has~~ told her husband that whether he agree with her or not she is not going to change her decision. **was**

⑨ The landlord said to the young man, "If you do not pay your rent by evening today, you will have to leave the house immediately."

→ The landlord ^{warned} ~~told~~ the young man that if he did not pay his rent by evening that day he would have to leave the house immediately.

(10) His wife said to him, "Do you know my servant stole our money?"

→ His wife ~~stole~~ asked him if he knew that her servant had stolen their money.

(11) Her friend said to her, "Can you spare your book for me for a week?"

→ Her friend ~~stole~~ asked her if she could spare her book for a week.

(12) She said to him, "Can I do anything for you? Will you mind extending help to you?"

→ She ~~stole~~ asked him if she could do anything for him if he would mind extending help to him.

(13) His friend said to him, "Did I not warn you against this beforehand?"

→ His friend asked him if he had not warned him against that beforehand.

(14) The captain said to the players, "Will you put your heart and soul in playing the game so that we may win the match?"

→ The captain ~~stole~~ asked the players if they would put their heart and soul in playing the game so that they might win the match.
