King also appoints officials.

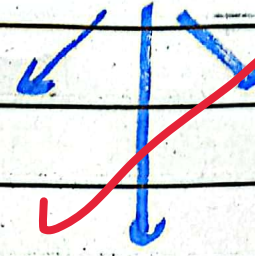
"All officials are appointed on the ~~request~~ of king."
