⇒ His brother told me that he was not going to attend the meeting that day.

7) The inspector said to the people, "we have caught the thief and he will be brought to book soon."

⇒ The inspector told the people that they had caught the thief and he would be brought to book soon.

8- The lady has said to her husband, "whether you agree with me or not I am not going to change my decision."

⇒ The lady ~~has~~ told her husband ~~that~~ whether he agreed with her or not she ~~was~~ not going to change her decisions.

9- The landlord said to the young man, "If you do not pay your rent by evening today you will have to leave the house immediately."

⇒ The landlord warned the young man that ~~if~~ he did not pay his rent ~~by~~ evening that day he would have to leave the house immediately.

10- His wife said to him, "Do you know that my servant stole our money?"

⇒ His wife told him that ~~Did~~ ~~he~~ knew that her servant ~~had~~ stolen their money.
