- Approach – Maximalist Approach

### Analysis Based Question

- Identify **KEYWORDS** of Question
- Develop a list of all Concepts – Examples (Which can be used)
- Write **INTRODUCTION** Paragraph (Summary/Abstract Methodology)
  - Thesis Statement
  - List of all Concepts (A number of terms can be used....)
  - List of examples (Many happenings including WWI, WWII, 9/11, etc..)
  - Reaffirmation of statement
- Rest Question – 1 PARAGRAPH 1 ARGUMENT
