

Effects of Flood

Floods damaged agriculture and its sub-sectors

One of the devastating effects of flood is on agriculture and its sub-sectors. Agriculture, the backbone of Pakistan's economy, has been hit hard in floods of 2022. Various important crops have been damaged. As a result, domestic price of essential food items including wheat flour, rice, cooking oil, pulses, milk and meat have spiked. Furthermore, a sharp rise in wheat and wheat flour, pulses, vegetables and livestock products prices during peak of floods in period between July-Sep 2022. The floods damaged the Kharif crops. The floods damaged the agriculture and its sub-sectors to the tune of Rs 800 bn or \$ 3.725 bn. Around 1,784,126 hectares (4,408,575 acres) of agriculture land have become derelict and over 8,00,000 animals died in six affected provinces and their 94 districts.
