

## Counterterrorism Effort

After the withdrawal of US troops from Afghanistan, a wave of enthusiasm was not <sup>only</sup> observed among the citizens of Pakistan but also the chief executive of the country. ~~Prime Minister~~ <sup>the then prime minister,</sup> of that ~~time~~, Imran Khan, was unable to curb his feelings of enthusiasm ~~as~~ and said;

Moreover, US is more concerned about the response of Pakistan's Military in terms of their relation with Taliban Regime. Another aspect is growing ~~Pakistan-China~~ strategic relationships. China is a threat for US and US is closely watching Pak-China relations in the region. It is the fact that Pakistan is not in a position to completely break relations with China due to the huge Chinese investment in the form of CPEC, but Pakistan should have to maintain a balance between its relations with US and China.

From US perspective, the scope of counter-terrorism cooperation is to completely ~~wipe~~ out already ~~weakened~~ Al-Qaeda as US considers it a
