restrictions on women rights and  
opportunities. For example traditional  
interpretation of religion context women  
should be subservient to men  
or they should not be allowed to  
work outside the home in Afghan  
societies. Society During Taliban government

Islamic law enforced which led to significant restriction on women's right and freedom. Women <sup>are</sup> were not allowed to work outside <sup>of</sup> the home, women are not allowed to leave home without a male relative. In sum, girls were banned from going to school, and women are not allowed to receive medical care from male doctors.

Traditional view women's role in family role of women is often defined by their responsibilities within the home and support to their husbands in many orthodox societies seen as inferior to men, and their roles are often limited to domestic sphere. They may have limited opportunities for education or participation in work force outside the home. Additionally, women <sup>are</sup> face bound to wear only <sup>traditional</sup> ~~Islamic~~ dresses than western dresses. Women are also expected to be submissive and obedient and their opinion

and ideas are not given much weight. Traditional view of women's role in society is often based on patriarchal values, where man is considered the head of the family and women are expected to submit to their authority. In nutshell, women role in orthodox societies is very limited.

The role of patriarchy in orthodox societies. Patriarchy plays a significant role in traditional and cultural norms. In patriarchal society men is considered to be dominant group and hold most of the power and authority, while women are expected to be submissive and obedient. In patriarchy families women are expected to be take care of home and children. Women are not allowed to get education the opportunities can also be limited and their ability to participate in decision making.
