i- GEO-STRATEGIC LOCATION OF PAKISTAN:




Figure # 1: map of Pakistan with neighbours.

As shows in the above map, Pakistan's location is of huge geo strategic importance in Asia to USA. In its west lies Afghanistan where US fought a 20 year long war on terrorism. In its East lies China which is a revisionary power and is of importance to USA. In South-East lies India which is strategic partner of USA.

ii- AFGHAN TALIBAN:

Curbing Terrorism has always been on the agenda of USA and Afghanistan had been the habinger of terrorism. Reports show that

after the withdrawal of US troops, terrorist organizations like ISIS and ISIS-K are becoming more interested in the country. Pakistan provided US bases in its northern region to spy on USR. Therefore, the country is still of huge importance to US with respect to Afghanistan.

iii - US CHINA RIVALRY AND PAKISTAN CHINA FRIENDSHIP:

China started to rise in 1990 and since then pivot to Asia has been the policy of US leaders. Pakistan shares its north-eastern border with China and both the countries have cordial relations. It is also truth that foreign policy can never be stringent and is very likely to change. Therefore, to keep an eye on China and its economic projects such as BRI, Pakistan is of great importance to US and US can get strategic benefit from it.

iv - US - INDIA STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP:

The Eastern neighbour of Pakistan i.e., India made relations

with USA in 2005. The relationship between the two countries is a threat to Pakistan since India and Pakistan have conflicts between them. On the other hand, US may, in order to increase its allies in Asia, to approach Pakistan for Partnership to balance China.

V. PAKISTAN NUCLEAR PROGRAM:

Since US is a superpower and bears the responsibility of non-proliferation of nuclear arms and protection of arms, it is concerned with the nuclear program of Pakistan. US has been insisting Pakistan to neutralize itself of nuclear arms and be a signer of non-proliferation Treaty. However, the country due to threat from eastern border is not likely to accede to the demand. This is another factor of US interest in Pakistan.
