3- Role of Planning Commission in Development

Planning Commission of Pakistan has a huge role in policy development for economic growth and infrastructure development. It has worked for it has been working since 1952 in Pakistan. Some of its important achievements are below.

④ Five Year Plans

Five year plan initiated in 1955. It was done by planning commission. The first three five year plans are very important for the country's economy. The average GDP of the country between 1955-78 was above 6%. However, after

1970 the country's economy started decline due to number of reasons.

(i) Lack of trained economist:-

Pakistan has lack of trained and professional economist till 1970. Moreover, the country faced huge economy shock due to fall of Dhaiker. Furthermore, the economy policy changed in 1970s.

(ii) Backwardness in Research Culture:-

The research culture is a reason of economy prosperity. In 1960, PIDE was made but it has lack of resources and political will. It ~~did not~~ work efficiently. The research culture was ~~not~~ inadequate to continue the policy forward.


(b) Medium Term Development Framework:

Planning Commission of Pakistan replaced 5 year plan with 3 year plans in 2000.

It is called Medium Term Development Framework. The last 5 year plan was 1998-03.


The MTDF was an outstanding achievement of DCP. The last plan was initiated in 2021.

(C) CPEC Cell:

The cornerstone of Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) is CPEC. It was signed in 2015 between Pakistan and China. It ~~was~~ invests a lot in energy and infrastructure development in Pakistan. CPEC cell ~~is~~ was established for planning, approval and negotiation of projects. It was headed by Chairman. There is a Joint Cooperation Committee (JCC) in which deputy chairman of CPEC cell and Chinese officials are member. It was under the supervision of Planning Commission.




(d) Sustainable Development Goal (SDG):

Millenium Development Goal (MDG) was the predecessor of Sustainable Development Goal.

MDGs formed for 15 years with 8 priorities. In 2015, it was replaced by SDGs. The purpose was sustainability of Climate, interconnection and Global achievements. It has 17 goals, 169 targets and 232 indicators.
