(Statistics of Drug Use in High School, americanaddictioncenters.org). This shows that the environment of learning in schools is not safe anymore.

Besides the failure to provide stable learning environment, schools are also criticized for providing only the formal education. Schools are focused on developing a workforce that is alienated from self, family and society and has developed only the workaholic skill in school. In these modern times, a person needs several skills or a skill set having variety that can help him to not only cope with the fast changing environment but also to act as a useful person in this environment. Unfortunately schools only specialize in providing the formal education but not the informal skill set.
