Neo-colonialism is a concept of second-half of 20th century. After the world war II, era of colonialization was ended. In

order to maintain hegemony, elites of the world took support of neo-colonialism. The concept of neo-colonialism prevailed within no time when western states giving aids and loans to the economically crippled states on the condition which did not let the states to develop. Today, global west is hegemon on global South. Economical, psychological,

Political and social influence of west
have been hindered the rest
of the world to develop.
Capitalism is a tool of
elites to maintain control
over the wealth of the
world. Moreover, education is
also used to influence
the mindset of dependent
nations. Globalization also
works to maintain hegemony
of either on the globe.
This is a new era of
colonialism. The means are
changed but objectives are
same. Explaining the colonized
states for development of
masters of the globe. Instead
of leaving territory, neo-colonialism is
erecting trade blocks on
economic, political and psychological
isolation of dependent states.
Colonialization was ended with
the help of United Nations
after the World War II,
but neo-colonialism has would be taken
decades to wash its footprint
from the global arena.

Neo-colonialism is
more detrimental to world
than colonialism, for many

reasons. First of all, economic dominance of rich states cripples sovereignty of poor states. Sovereignty of dependent states is breached by dominant state owing to the curse

of neo-colonialism. Economic needs of the world are in the hands of elites and International Monetary Fund,

World Bank these two global economic institutes are being used by the west to

colonialize the rest of the world. When loan is given

by IMF, it comes with Structural adjustment Program (SAPs).

These programs have bleak impacts on the sovereignty

of the states. Moreover, elites of the west colonialize the

poors through debt trap, as have been seen in the case

of Sri Lanka. So, hegemony of imperialism of west on

economical needs of the world makes the poor

state victim of neo-colonialism. Besides this,

elites use their hegemonic status to make decision

on international arena for the whole world. Poor

States do not have their say on international level. Decisions which are taken by the global hegemon here to be followed by all in this global village. For example, Russia, Ukraine was an initiative of NATO, Sanctions or imposed on Russia by the elites which have resulted into a bleak way for the whole world. Besides this, steps of elites to shift towards renewable resources have triggered the energy and food crisis in the whole world. They make decisions which are always in the favour of them. Rest of the world has to pay with cost. So, decision making power of elites is neo-colonialist world is stagnating the poor states.

Along with there, another curse of neo-colonialism is the xenocentrism in power which strengthens the position of the world's elites. Rich states adopt different tools to influence culture of poor states. They proliferate

their culture in their dominated states
For example, media is a big
tool to spread neo-colonialism in
under developed states. This effect
cultural values of poor states where
western culture spread with rocket
speed. Along with media, multi-
national corporations also impact culture
of host states for example
burger, pizzas and other fast
foods are products of western
food chains which have changed
eating habits of Pakistan's
nations. From edible to costume,
everything is impacted owing
to the curse of neo-
colonialism, and culture of
elite prevails in the
world. at the cost of
that of poor.

Over and
above, foreign policies of
slaved states are framed by
master states. due to the
sinisters of neo-colonialism
Elites have full control
on the international relations.
Dependent states have to
follow the instructions and
compliance of master states
For example, Pakistan's foreign
policy is always remained.

conjure owing to influence of
United States. Since its
inception, Pakistan has remained an
hegemon in its affairs. Its
foreign policy has always been
framed in a way which
is favourable for America.
Pakistan has paid a
heavy cost of this
in the form of strained
relations with multiple regional
friends as stated by Abdul
Sater in his book, Pakistan's
foreign policy. So, dependent
states have to design their
foreign policies on the conditions
of elite due to their
economical dependency.

Furthermore,
regime change operation is a
new tool of neo-colonialism
which is used by elites
to breach political sovereignty
of dependent states. Political
system of poor states is
also influenced by master
states. In this way,
they have full control
on the affairs of
dependent states. For example,
Iran's government was toppled by
west in 1950's to exploit its

resources.

In 2003 Iraq government was criticized

Prime Minister has been accusing
foreign States behind conspiracy
of regime change. Thus, political
sector can not remain idle
aloof from the bleak sinister
of neo-colonialism.

In addition
to these curses, neo-colonialism
leads to psychological colonialism
which spawns a bleak
generation of beggars. Master
of the world use media,
economic system and international
institutes to pry their
hegemonic tendencies. This makes
dependent nations psychological
slaves for example, "Begger
cannot be the choosers." was
a statement of Pakistan's
current Prime minister. He
was meant to bow before
the dominant states without
arguing because of Pakistan's
dependency on them. Psychologically,
the dominated nation is influenced
by developed states to great
extent due to the biased
usage of stabilization. Every
citizen of developing states want

to fly towards western states for better
life standard. This psychological
colonialism cannot be mitigated
by any organization. This
has more acute impacts
on the nations as compare
to colonialism.

There is
dire need of time to take
some pragmatic measures by
the governments to mitigate the
black curses of neo-colonialism
first of all, states should
be economically independent
to topple the regime of
western states from global
village. Economic dependency
is major tool of neo-colonialism,
economic instability makes states
bigger of elites and they
utilize this instability to
sustain their hegemony on
poors. For example, Pakistan
depends on IMF, WB and
others' loans and aids for
economic stability. All these
use the economic dependency
of Pakistan to fulfill their
gains. Pakistan should be
economically independent which can
be done only through industrialization.

as stated in Why Nations Fail.
So economic stability is the first
step towards independency.

Besides economic
stability, centers of states should
be strong to counter any foreign
conspiracy. Strong centers are the
sign of strong states. Centers
should be strong enough to
face any sort of hegemonic
attack by invaders. "No civilization
can be destroyed from without
unless it destroy itself from
within". The story of civilization,
Ariel Durant. This quote of
the author shows that to
topple a state, it must
be destroyed itself from
within. One of major reasons
behind destruction of Sri-Lanka
was its weak center.
It was unstable internally
which aggravated other issues
to rise. Pakistan has
also weak center which
let foreigners to interfere
in its matters.
So, center of a
state should be strong
to counter all the
invaders, and to assure stability
of the state.

Moreover, there should be a complete ban on the media content which glorify xeno-centrism. Media is one of the major tool behind the proliferation of neo-colonialism. Unfiltered content leads to xeno-centrism where nations have sense of inferiority for their cultural or Ethical values. For example, in almost all the Bollywood or Hollywood movies, terrorists and violent actors always belong to the Islam and Muslim States. This deteriorate culture and value of Islam. It also has bleak impacts on the development of Muslim States. There should be a complete ban on the social media content which spread hate against the State's culture and values. It would help to halt the electronic intrigues of the evil states against our State, and to mitigate xeno-centrism. Resultantly, Psychological colonialism would be ended.
