1. Introduction:-

At present Muslims are facing numerous challenges that have caused a serious damage to their overall development. Muslims today occupy the lowest position in the ladder of the global world. They are educationally backwards, have even lost their moral values, politically instable and economically poor. They were economically rich and involved in enormous business and economic activities. However, now it seems that they have diverted from their old traditions.

2. Challenges faced by Muslim Ummah:-

In this modern age Muslim ummah is facing numerous challenges that have caused a serious damage to its stability, its image as well as its economy. Some of the contemporary challenges faced by Muslim Ummah are described below.

a. Disunity among Muslims:-

The immediate and most serious issue faced by Muslim Ummah is disunity among them. Islam has established a bond of brotherhood among Muslims in spite of it all there is no unity in Muslims. There are almost 50 Muslim Countries in the world. 30 of them possess 90% Muslim population and remaining countries have Muslim population between 50% to 80%. Almost 25% of the population of world is Muslim. Saudi Arabia and Iran are extreme rivals. If Muslim countries are united and start helping each other they would not require any sort of assistance from their

western allies. Muslim countries like Iran and Saudi Arabia are rich in oil resources. Others like Malaysia and Turkey are advance in Technology. Pakistan possesses a nuclear weapon and well professional army. If Muslim countries help each other in above mentioned areas and many others they can be recognized globally.

b. Rapid rise of terrorism and extremism.

Another major challenge confronting by Muslim ummah is the rapid rise of terrorism and extremism in Muslim countries. It is due to the fact that Muslim countries are unable to prevent the spread of racial material in their educational institution. Along with it, terrorism and extremism is the born of Soviet union invasion of Afghanistan. This terrorism and extremism has given rise to Islamophobia. c. Lagging behind in Education:-

(Benazir Bhutto).

Benazir Bhutto writes in her book, Reconciliation: Islam Democracy and the West:

"Muslim countries have total of 500 universities as compared to 5,000 universities in USA and 8,000 universities in India."

This fact can clearly be used to understand and interest of Muslim countries as compared to the west. Dubai and Saudi Arabia are spending millions of dollars in constructing world's highest buildings and biggest malls. But have no considerations towards increasing educational institutes and research centres.

d. Weak Economic Status of Muslims

Countries:-

Most of the Muslim countries are economically weak. For instance, the total world's trade of OIC countries is less than a single country, China. Average per capita of Muslim world, a part from their oil revenues, is below the world's average. Some Muslim countries are rich because of their oil revenues. Muslim countries need to work together and help one another, so they can improve their economic status.

e. un-Islamic Authoritarian Rule:-

Authoritarianism is not un-Islamic. Otherwise all caliphate would be proved un-Islamic

Most of the Arab countries are run by authoritarian rule that is condemned by Islam. Owing to one man or family ruling system, there is seen misused of government's authority and power. Middle class people are pushed back and are not given opportunity to run the state. As a result, crisis of governance is often witnessed. Authoritarian rule may also lead

to human rights abuses and suppression of minorities. The one-family rule has caused much damage to the overall better development of the Arab countries.

f. Corruption and Wrong intentions -

Corruption and ill will is one of the major underlying issue of some of the Muslim countries. This is found all levels of the Muslim societies. It is one of the major factor of decline of Muslim countries. People in these countries are ruling with money. The one has money can easily get a job, can easily win a case. All affairs of life are easy for him. People in societies have ill will towards each others. All these have portrayed a negative image of Muslims in the west.

g. Injustice and unfairness:-

There is a famous saying of Hazrat Ali (R.A) "Societies can exist with Kufir but not with injustice."

Today, in Muslim Countries injustice has taken many forms. we can witness injustice of other nations upon muslim ummah, but we can also witness it at the position of one in Authority. There is no fair means of selection for particular jobs, all they need for allocation is corruption or source of a minister. h. Instability of Self-Reform.

Media is portraying Islam as out dated religion and saying to reform it. Youth of muslim countries are being told that Islam needs reformation according to current times. 3. Solutions for challenges in the Light of teachings of Islam:-

The issues mentioned above are the serious issues and need solutions. Belows are few solutions which can help muslim Ummah to regain their status in the world and to flourish again.

a. Muslims should unite under the umbrella of Islam:-

Similar was the message of Holy Prophet (PBUH) in his Last sermon.

Muslim of every country either it be white man of Pakistan or black of Indonesia. All are equal and the whole Muslim Ummah should be united for the cause of their prosperity and success.

b. Justice is necessary to maintain
peace and stability.

Allah says in the Holy Quran:

"Act justly, that is nearer to God fearing."

Allah himself have asked Muslims to act justly as being unjust is the cause of many evil problems.

d. Muslim Rulers need to follow the Examples of Pious Caliphate:-
