3. Pakistan is not prepared for 5th generation warfare (Thesis)

(a) Ideological divide and separatist movements weakening Pakistan Balochistan Liberation Army (BLA). From 2010 to 2015, organized political violence events linked to the insurgency gradually increased, peaking in 2015 with 96 events and 383 total reported fatalities for the year (Relief Web)

(b) Misuse of Islamic aspect to undermine the state Religion decades old rift between two major sects i.e Shia and Sunni creating an atmosphere of hatred and polarity among nation. The attacks on Hazara community of Pakistan Misuse of Blasphemy (266 Cases in 2020-2021, 59 Christian females and 600 males Sunnis since independence)

(c) Irresponsible Media and Exploitation of information to spread mistrust in people.

According to European Union Disinformation Task Force released report in early October 2019, around 265 coordinated fake local media outlets are serving Indian interests in nearly 65 countries. Their IP address traces back to Sivasta Group which is home to New Delhi Times and International Institute for Non-aligned

Studies (IINS).

 pitting nation against the state

(e) Failure of Cyber security systems in stopping the hacker's

(e) Cyber Attacks have increased past two years instead of halting

The end of September 2021, cyberattacks had already succeeded by 17% as compared to 2020. On October 19, 2021, NBP's services went down due to a cyber attack. As per Finance Minister Shaukat Tareen, the FBR faces 71,000 cyberattacks every month. This year on 15th August FBR website was not available for 24 hours against any attack suspicion.
