Therefore, there are various evidence can be quote here.

An other example that when Nancy Pelosi visited Taiwan then China's President Xi Jinping said to Joe Biden on call that "Don't play with fire". These facts shows that China is emerging very rapidly. In fact, world order is changing from Unipolar to multipolar.

Besides the transition from unipolar to multipolar, transformation from geo-strategic to geo-economic is an other change in world order. Therefore, every state wants its hegemony in the region. However, every rising country is trying to plan long term economic policies for its hegemony. For example, China's project of One Belt and One road initiative for economic hegemony in the region. Besides BRI, the USA initiative of B3W for counter of China in economic hegemony. In fact transformation from geo-strategic

to geo-economic is another change in the world order.

The third change in world order is formation of alliances and counter alliances in the world. Therefore, every world power wants to make alliance for their strong back support. The USA and China are trying to connect world with them through alliances. For example, NATO alliance of the USA and QUAD to counter China in the region.
