This check and balance system is one of the most powerful weapons in the US constitution which makes it one of the most important written documents in World.

First three articles of the Constitution of USA The Constitution of America Provides direct safeguards to the firedom of all Americans as the first three articles of Constitution of USA describes the Specific Powers given to all three branches of the government to established a balance of Power. Each branch has powers that it can use to Check and balance the operation of other two branches.

The core idea of the system of check and balance was that no one branch of government should be able to get too far out of control without being in check by others.
