When people started realizing the adverse impact of industrialization they started uprising that led to political and scientific efforts of the leaders.

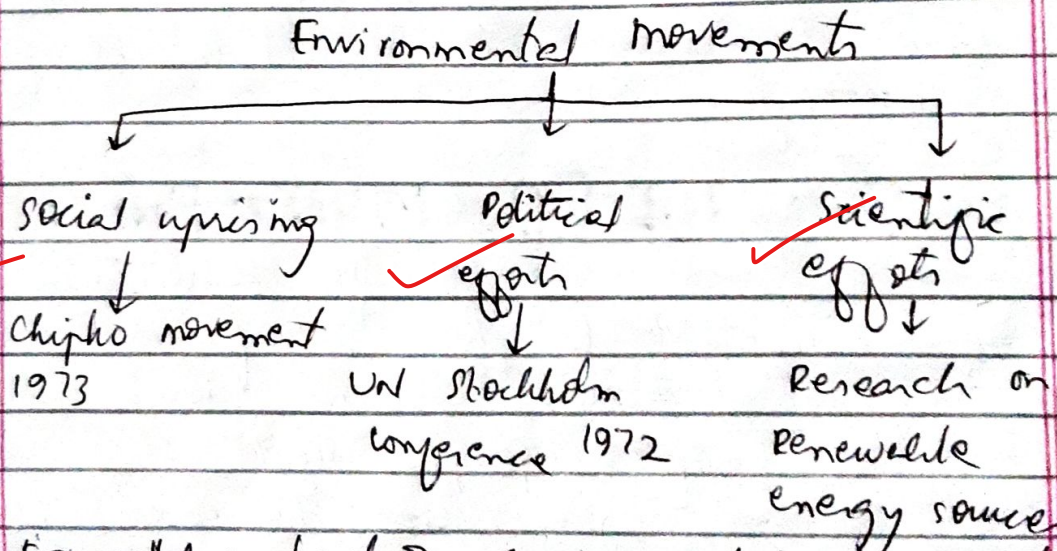


Figure #1: tools of environmental movements

- 1869 — Protection of Sea Bird act of UK
- 1961 — World Wildlife Fund
- 1962 — Silent Spring by Rachel Carson
- 1969 — Greenpeace and Friends of Earth organization was formed.
- 1970 — First Earth Day was celebrated
- 1972 — Stockholm conference.
- 1973 — Chipko movement in Bhopal, India
- 1973 — Silent Valley
- 1979 — Beginning of Green politics, values party of New Zealand was formed
- 1980 — German Green Party was found
- 1987 — Brundtland Report and concept of sustainable development
- 1992 — Rio Summit and Agenda 21
- 2000 — Millennium Development Goals
- 2015 — Sustainable Development Goals
- 2015 — Paris Climate Accord
- 2022 — COP27 and Damage and Restoration Fund
- 2022 — Green Politics is also in and onwards continuation

4 - PHASES OF ENVIRONMENTAL MOVEMENTS:

The timeline shows that the environmental movements are in continuation since more than a century. These years can be divided into phases.

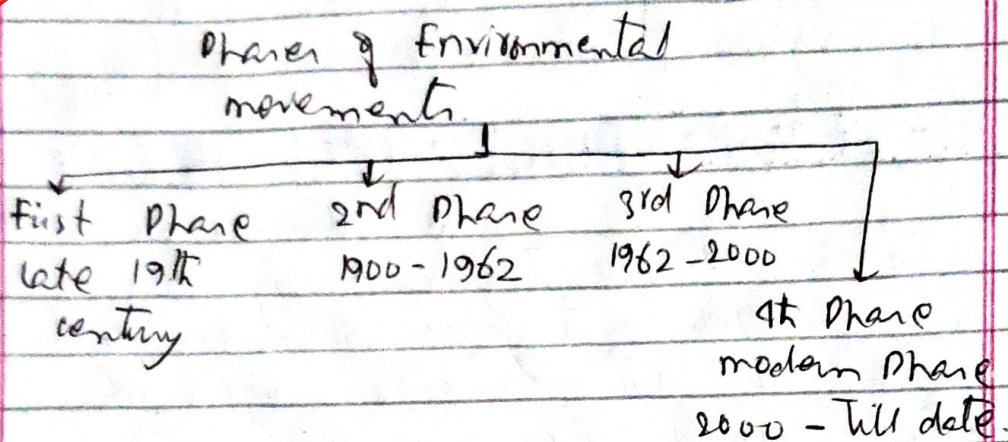


Figure # 2: Phases of environmental movements

I - FIRST PHASE: 19th CENTURY:

Industrial Revolution expanded to whole world by mid of 19th century. The adverse impact of the exploitation of resources such as fossil fuel and water bodies were also observed then.

a - Alkali Act of 1963:

In 1963, UK passed the Alkali Act. It was passed to curb the discharge of dangerous gases to air.

to prevent air pollution.

b - Protection of Sea Bird Act of 1869.

The hunting of sea bird was at its peak in 1860s in UK. There was a serious threat of extinction of these birds. Therefore, the parliament imposed a limitation on hunting to prevent loss of biodiversity.

ii - SECOND PHASE: 1900-1962:

The situation was worst in 20th century and by the mid of 20th century, environment was given its due attention. Organizations were found, Green political parties were found, people started protests and political leaders started taking steps.

a - Formation of organizations:

in 1961, World Wildlife Fund was found. Its main aim was the preservation of wildlife but today the aim has expanded. Hereafter in 1969, Greenpeace and Friends of Earth was also founded.

b - Intellectuals started writing:

writers and authors of that time took notice and wrote

about the damage human had done to the environment. In 1962, Rachel Carson wrote Silent Spring and set the theme on fire. Moreover, Ralph Nader wroteUnsafe at any speed in 1965.

iii - THIRD PHASE: 1962 - 2000:

c - Social uprising:

After the publication of Silent Spring, people also started uprising. Chipko movement was run in Bhopal, India in 1973 to prevent deforestation. Another such event took place in India in 1973 named Silent Valley.

d - Political aspects and environment began to be on the agenda of Global leaders:

In 1972, first conference on the theme of environment, was held in Stockholm named UN conference on human environment 1972. Hereafter, a series of conventions, protocols and accords started such as Rio Summit 1992, Agenda 21, MPOs and SDGs.

e - Beginning of Green Politics:

It was in 20th century, when Green Politics began. In 1979, the first ever Green Party

was formed in New Zealand named
Value Party. Hereafter, German
Green Party was formed in 1980.
These parties' main agenda is
protection of environment.

IV - 4th PHASE: MODERN PHASE: 2000 - TILL DATE:

By the end of
20th century, the ~~efforts~~ to ~~conserve~~
and ~~protect~~ environment were
expedited. The ~~question~~ is still

human's negligent behaviour can
be seen in terms of disaster.

a - Efforts at international level:
In 21st century, political
leaders are doing efforts to reverse
the damage their predecessors have
done to environment. For example,
Sustainable Development Goals of
2015, Paris Climate Accord 2015 and
COP 27.

b - Social uprising:
Society there are uprisings
and demonstrations. There are
environmental activists. Some of the
leading names are Greta Thunberg,
Anna Core and ~~Disha~~ Ravi. Moreover,

the protest of underdeveloped and poor countries to demand the damage is also another kind of environmental movement.

c- Green Politics:

~~countries~~ are practising Green Politics. Current President of Chile, named Gabriel Boric is a member of Green Party. Gustavo Petro is also a Green Party leader in Columbia. Both of these leaders are pursuing Green Politics.

The above analysis shows that with the passage of time, environmental movements have gathered momentum and expanded globally.

5-MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN THE VOICE OF GREEN DRIVE:

The world realized the environmental degradation in 20th century, but the situation is out of control even today.
